## **I. BACKGROUND**

The “Work Will Always Pay...With MFIP” handouts were last issued in bulletin #06-11-03. This bulletin replaces bulletin #06-11-03. All handouts copied from the prior bulletin should be destroyed. The attached handouts have been updated based on state law which requires Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP) transitional standards be adjusted each year in October to reflect the federal Food Stamp program’s cost-of-living increase and to maintain the MFIP program’s exit level for working families at the level required in state law. The exit level required in statute is 115% of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG) for a household size of three. State law requires the exit level be maintained by adjusting the MFIP disregard. The disregard is being increased from 38% to 39% of gross earnings to maintain the 115% FPG exit level for a household size of three. Other household sizes may exit at higher or lower than the 115% FPG level.

The revised handouts include family sizes one through ten. There are five earning amount examples for each household size:

- not working,
- working 20 hours per week at \$6.15/hour,
- working 30 hours per week at \$6.15/hour,
- amount a family must earn for a month to not count against the 60-month limit, and
- maximum amount a family can earn before MFIP eligibility ends.

Families that do not receive cash (receive food only) count as a success for the MFIP Self Support Index. The federal work participation requirement for a single caregiver whose youngest child is under six years of age is 87 hours a month and for a single caregiver whose youngest child is six years of age or older is 130 hours per month. Other activities besides employment can count towards the work participation requirement.

## **II. IMPLEMENTATION**

Provide handouts to MFIP participants to help them understand the benefit of increased earnings and explain how income can be increased even more through tax credits. Advise families to take advantage of free tax preparation sites available statewide between February 1 and April 15.
