Title IV-E Per Diem Rates for Children's Residential Foster Care Facilities and MA Percents for Residential Facilities with Mental Health Certification

TOPIC

Quarterly list of per diem rates and percentages for Title IV-E eligible group residential facilities and Rule 4 placing agencies effective October 1, 2007, and list of MA percentages for eligible children's group residential facilities with mental health certification.

PURPOSE

Inform county agencies of per diem and percentage rates to use when claiming Title IV-E federal reimbursement for group residential facilities, and Rule 4 agencies per revised lead county contracts. Inform counties of percentages to use when claiming Medical Assistance (MA) federal reimbursement for eligible children's group residential facilities with mental health certification. Provide forms for use in reporting rate changes, lead county contract renewals and facility closings.

BACKGROUND

For purposes of Title IV-E claims, DHS publishes on a quarterly basis, a list of recognized per diem rates and percentages for specific children's group residential facilities. These figures are used in completing the Title IV-E Foster Care Program Abstract (DHS-2570) according to DHS bulletin no. 07-32-09 (July 5, 2007). Claims are then submitted through the Social Services Information System (SSIS). In addition, DHS lists children's residential facilities with mental health certification that are eligible to receive MA in order to assist counties in claiming federal MA reimbursement.

The per diem rates are established when the lead county (host county) establishes or amends the contract and properly notifies DHS using form DHS-2825.

Percentages in this bulletin are effective for dates of service in federal fiscal year 2008 (October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2008). DHS calculates percentages using time studies and cost reports from the participating facilities. These percentages represent the portions of the per diem which are federally reimbursable under requirements of Title IV-E.

SPECIAL NOTE

The Group 3 Correctional Family Foster Home page has been deleted from Attachment A of this bulletin. Beginning July 1, 2007, family foster homes licensed by the Department of Corrections (DOC) are also licensed and maintained in the DHS licensing system. It is no longer necessary to list the family foster homes licensed by the DOC in the quarterly per diem bulletin.

To claim difficulty-of-care reimbursement on the IV-E Abstract, all family foster homes will be identified by their DHS (DOC) license number and coded as Rule 1 homes.

OVERVIEW OF ATTACHMENT A: PER DIEM RATES AND PERCENTAGES

Each page of Attachment A has the same format. All pages contain the same column headings. However, not all columns contain data, as each page does not have the same required data elements.

Only Group 1 and Group 2 residential facilities have been reviewed and approved as Title IV-E eligible facilities. Some facilities moved from the Group 2 list (which uses median percentages) to the Group 1 list due to the submission of cost reports or participation in the group facility time study (which uses facility-specific percentages).

Group 1 – Children's group residential facilities with mental health certification are eligible for MA reimbursement as well as Title IV-E. The approved MA percentage is the percentage of the per diem eligible for MA reimbursement. This data should *not* be entered into the Title IV-E abstract software. MA claims must be submitted to MMIS. The MA information is published to assist counties in claiming federal MA reimbursement.

Group 4 – Rule 4 (Minnesota Rules, Parts 9545.0755-9545.0845), child-placing agencies are used to recognize the administrative per diems of eligible Rule 4 agencies. The Rule 4 agencies appearing in Group 4 have chosen to participate in the Placing Agency Time Study (PATs) and, therefore, a portion of the administrative fee charged to counties for children placed in family foster homes through these Rule 4 agencies is eligible for Title IV-E reimbursement.

OVERVIEW OF ATTACHMENT B: NOTICE OF PER DIEM RATE CHANGE

Attachment B, DHS-2825, is required when submitting changes to current facilities and/or programs regarding contracts and daily per diems. It is also required when requesting Title IV-E eligibility approval for new facilities and/or programs.

OVERVIEW OF ATTACHMENT C: TITLE IV-E FACILITIES CHECKLIST

Attachment C, Title IV-E Facilities Checklist, is required and must be submitted when requesting Title IV-E eligibility approval for new facilities and/or programs.

OVERVIEW OF ATTACHMENT D: FACILITIES LICENSED BY CORRECTIONS

Attachment D was added to this bulletin in response to county requests for more information about facilities licensed by the Department of Corrections. This attachment lists all juvenile correctional facilities licensed by the Department of Corrections. The facilities are listed alphabetically and include location and security status of the beds. Remember that **not all of these facilities are Title IV-E eligible**. If a program from a licensed correctional facility is Title IV-E eligible, it will be listed in Attachment A.

ACTION REQUIRED

- **Use Current Per Diem Rates**

Title IV-E claims must reflect the per diem rates shown in Attachment A for service dates of October 1 through December 31, 2007. This replaces Attachment A; bulletin no. 07-32-16 (September 25, 2007) which included the rates effective for service dates of July 1, 2007 through September 30, 2007.

- **Follow Procedures for All New Facilities**

For new facilities and/or programs to become Title IV-E eligible, counties must submit:

- DHS-2825, *Notice of Per Diem Rate Change* (Attachment B)
- The Title IV-E Facility Checklist (Attachment C)
- A copy of the group facility license
- Information on the facility and its programs offered

For new Rule 4 placing agencies and/or programs to become Title IV-E eligible, counties must submit:

- DHS-2825, *Notice of Per Diem Rate Change* (Attachment B)
- A copy of the Rule 4 license.

The eligibility determination process can take time; therefore, DHS recommends that lead counties submit the required materials within the first 30 days of the calendar quarter.

If all requested documentation has been received within the first 30 days of the quarter, determination can be made in that same quarter. Approval or denial notifications, with an explanation for denials, will be sent to the lead county.

In some instances, further research or follow up may be required to determine eligibility. If this is the case, it may delay the determination process and result in a later effective date.

- **Notify DHS of Per Diem Rate Changes**

County agencies must notify DHS of per diem rate changes involving covered group residential facilities and Rule 4 placing agencies. For Title IV-E claiming purposes, DHS will implement changes in per diem rates on the first day of the first full calendar quarter for which the rates are effective.

Lead county human service agencies must notify DHS of per diem rate changes for all facilities appearing on the DHS lists of Group 1, Participating Group Facilities, Group 2, new Title IV-E eligible facilities and Group 4, Title IV-E Eligible Rule 4 child placing agencies (Attachment A). DHS-2825 is to be used for this purpose (Attachment B).

It is recommended that lead counties negotiate per diem rate changes to be effective on the first day of a quarter and that these changes cover the entire quarter. Counties should then notify DHS using DHS-2825 within the first 30 days of that quarter. This will maximize federal Title IV-E revenue to all counties. DHS-2825 must be signed by the director of the lead county or an official authorized to sign for the director.

EXAMPLE 1: The lead county contract specifies a new rate effective January 1, 2008 and DHS receives the rate change form (DHS-2825) on or before January 30, 2008. The new per diem may be used for Title IV-E claims for service dates of January 1, 2008 and thereafter.

EXAMPLE 2: The lead county contract specifies a new rate effective January 1, 2008 and DHS receives the rate change form (DHS-2825) on January 31, 2008. The new per diem does *not* become effective for Title IV-E claims until April 1, 2008.

EXAMPLE 3: The lead county contract specifies a new rate effective January 2, 2008 and DHS receives the rate change form on or before January 30, 2008, even on January 3. The new per diem does *not* become effective for Title IV-E claims until April 1, 2008.

- **Notify DHS of Lead County Contract Renewal**

Lead county human service agencies must notify DHS if a new lead county contract has been negotiated, even when the per diem rate has not increased, or if an existing contract is extended. The *Notice of Per Diem Rate Change*, DHS-2825, is to be used for this purpose.

- **Notify DHS of Closed Facilities**

County agencies are asked to submit written notification to DHS when a group facility or placing agency has closed or is in the process of closing including the date of closure.

- **Procedures for Out-of-State Facilities**

To keep accurate records of out-of-state facilities, DHS requests that the lead county submit the DHS-2825 (Attachment B) along with documentation identifying the facility as Title IV-E approved by its home state, and include a copy of the facility's current license(s) and program description. To keep the list of out-of-state facilities current, submit copies of all license renewals. If the license expires, the facility will be removed from the list.

USE CORRECT RULE CODE FOR EACH TYPE OF FACILITY

Each claim must be identified using the correct rule code.

Rule Codes for Family Type Claims

- **Rule Code 1 for Family Foster Homes Licensed by DHS & DOC**

Use rule code **1** for Family Foster Homes licensed under authority of DHS and Department of Corrections (DOC).

- **Rule Code 4 for Child Placing Agencies**

Use rule code **4** for child placing agencies licensed under authority of DHS with a Rule 4 license.

- **OT2 Code for Indian Family Foster Homes**

Use code **OT2** for Indian family foster homes licensed or approved by tribal governments. (When using this code, enter the exact phrase *INDIAN* in the license number field.)

- **OSH Code for Out-of-State Family Foster Homes**

Use code **OSH** for out-of-state family foster homes licensed by the state where the home is located. (Enter the exact phrase *O of S* in the license number field when using this code.)

Rule codes for Group Type Claims

- **Rule Code 5 for Group Residential Facilities with Mental Health Certification**

Use rule code **5** for residential facilities with mental health certification, licensed under authority of DHS.

- **Rule Code 8 for Group Residential Homes and Shelters**

Use rule code **8** for group residential homes and shelters, licensed under authority of DHS.

- **Rule Code 22 for Transitional Living Facilities**

Use rule code **22** for transitional living facilities, licensed under authority of DHS with a Rule 22 license.

- **Rule Code 31 for Group Residential facilities with Chemical Dependency Certification**

Use rule code **31** for group residential facilities with chemical dependency certification, licensed under authority of DHS with a Rule 31 (Minnesota Rules, Parts 9530.6405-9530.6505) license.

- **CP Code for Group Facilities Licensed by Corrections**

Use code **CP** for approved group residential facilities licensed by the Department of Corrections with correctional program certification. These group facilities will appear in Group 1 All Other Residential Facilities (Attachment A).

- **OSF Code for Frequently Used Out-of-state Facilities**

Use code **OSF** for out-of-state facilities licensed by the state where the facility is located. The frequently used out-of-state facilities are in Group 2 (Attachment A). DHS no longer categorizes these facilities as similar to either the former DHS Rule 5 or Rule 8 type facilities.

- **TR Code for American Indian Facilities**

Use code **TR** for all tribal-approved American Indian group residential facilities.

USE CORRECT LICENSE OR AUTOMATION NUMBER

- **Assigned Automation Numbers**

The DHS auditing process requires the use of a license number or code number equivalent to a license number for each placement type. For this reason, all facilities and group homes coded as tribal, corrections or out-of-state have been assigned a Title IV-E automation number.

Corrections have automated numbers that begin with DC; out-of-state facilities begin with OSF; and tribal approved facilities begin with "TR."

Each Rule 4 placing agency has a DHS-assigned provider ID license number. For Rule 4 placing agencies having more than one administrative per diem included in the governing lead county contract, each per diem has been assigned a unique sub-code.

- **Sub Codes**

Sub codes have been assigned to facilities that operate multiple programs under the same DHS license number. Correctional facilities are also defined by sub codes when more than one program is operated by the same facility. The sub code is a one-character extension of the license number. It is important to pay attention to the dates of service for each claim when determining which rule code and sub code to use on the Title IV-E Abstract.
