Federal Government Updates Poverty Guidelines for 2007

TOPIC

The 2007 Federal Poverty Guidelines.

PURPOSE

Provide information counties need to comply with Minnesota Statutes, section 256M.60, subdivision 6. This statute specifies that county boards must not charge social services fees to persons or families whose adjusted gross household income is below the poverty level established by the Federal Poverty Guidelines. The 2007 guidelines are effective immediately.

ACTION/DUE DATE

Follow new 2007 guidelines.

EXPIRATION DATE

These policies expire on the earlier of May 1, 2009, or the issuance of new Federal Poverty Guidelines.
