TERMINOLOGY NOTICE

The terminology used to describe people we serve has changed over time. The Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) supports the use of "People First" language.

Background

The Department of Human Services (DHS) calculates interim charges on a per diem basis each fiscal year (July 1 thru June 30) by dividing the sum of all anticipated costs by the funded bed capacity. Rates are an average of all services provided by each program.

Effective July 1, 2018 the charges for care are as follows:
