RESOLUTION

STATEMENT

The Moorhead Schools have been faced with increasing enrollments for many years. The total enrollment in 1945-46 was 1738, in 1950-51 this had been increased to 2025 with the present total being 2848. Forty-two classrooms with other facilities were added by issuing \$1,615,000 in bonds.

At the present time the most acute need is in the junior high school where the enrollment has increased 62% in ten years. A building designed for less than 500 is bulging with 700 pupils. This increase is gradually being felt in the senior high school which has experienced an increase of 40% in ten years. The faculty members in the junior high school are teaching large classes ~~which is to the detriment~~ to the detriment of the pupils.

The Board of Education in district 2 is now faced with the problem of engaging architects to plan for enlarging the facilities to provide for this increase in enrollment. ~~It~~ It is imperative that the members of ~~the~~ Board know how extensive these additional ~~building~~ programs should be.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

1. ~~That~~ the Board of Education of District 2, Moorhead, Minnesota, expresses its sincere appreciation to the Survey Board and to the many persons who have assisted them in their school problem.

2. Because ~~a~~ a board's primary obligation must be to the resident pupils of its own district the Board of Education of District Two has found it necessary to provide education ~~for resident pupils only~~ in the junior high school including grades 7, 8, and 9 beginning September 1, 1956.

The above resolution was duly made, seconded, and adopted on October 4, ~~1955~~ 1955, at a regular meeting of the Board of Education, District 2, Moorhead, Minnesota.


