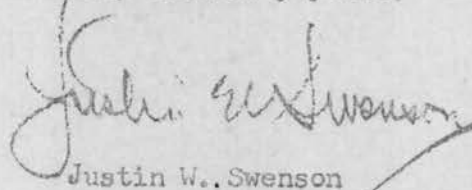

2. Resolution to close School in former District 21 building and to terminate the contract for Mrs. Bertha Mondry who has been teaching in this building.

3. Approval of tuition agreement with St. Cloud Vocational School for tuition for Wayne Czichotzki for course in Pre-Apprentice Bricklaying. This is in accordance with state laws. We will receive basic aid and apportionment for this student as though he were attending our school.

4. Naming of the new junior high schools.

5. Work-announcement regarding visits to steel buildings scheduled for Friday.

6. Legislation- Letter from Sch Bd Association indicates that one proposal regarding the teacher retirement Fund will call for a 7% payroll tax for the next 40 years to be paid by school boards plus an additional 6% by teachers. We should oppose this because this is an obligation of the State.
