RIVERVIEW INDUSTRIAL PARK ACQUISITION

Resolution No. 123, August 9, 1960 declared Riverview an Industrial Development District

Resolution No. 193, November 20, 1962 approved the acquisition of the property

Resolution No. 198, January 22, 1963 approved the the first property acquisitions

Businesses - Approximately 28 plus one church, one school, one rail yard.

The total acquisition contained approximately 520 parcels.

About 45% of the residents in the project area were between age 0 to 18 years or 1290 children.

About 10% of the residents were persons of 62 years of age or older.

Based upon income and size of households, over 64% are apparently eligible for public housing accommodations. Generally, income level is relatively low.

There were 105 persons and/or families receiving some form of public assistance.
