It is apparent that this owner has assembled a number of lots into one large tract with frontage of 350 feet on Eaton Avenue with an additional 50 feet of frontage also on Eaton Avenue immediately East of Greenwood Avenue. This tract also has the advantage of railroad trackage.

According to the 1959 map of the Public Works Department of the City of St. Paul there is no sewer on Eaton Avenue or Greenwood Avenue. The Water Department informed me that there is no water in the street at this location. Land is level with street grade.

Eaton Avenue and Greenwood Avenue are both graded streets with gravel oiled. There is no sidewalk or curb.

This property at present is being used as a scrap or wrecked auto yard where automobiles are dismanteled after usable parts have been removed.

The property contains some frame sheds of little value and is enclosed with a fair seven or eight foot part wood, part wire fence.

We have made a survey of the entire area of which subject property is a part. The square foot rate on normal heavy industry zoning has been set at approximately 15¢ per square foot. Because of the trackage available we have extablished a rate on subject property of 20¢ per square foot.
