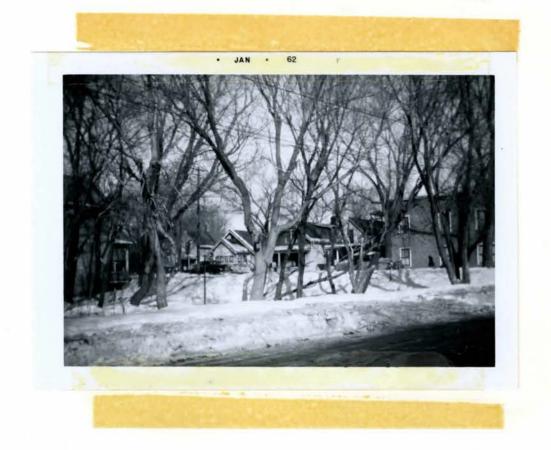

Description of Property:

Subject properties are two vacant lots fronting on Robertson, each with 50' of frontage. Lot 9 is an inside lot and Lot 10 is a corner lot with 50' of frontage on Robertson and 100' of depth along E. Chicago. The majority of both lots lie between 5 and 6 feet below grade. There are several trees on the lot. The lots are served by improved streets with city facilities available.

VALUATION

Using the comparable sales and offering data for vacant land found elsewhere in this report, it is the opinion of your appraisers that a package value exists in the combination of the 2 lots in question. The land then becomes one package of 100' x 100'. The factors of scrub trees and that the lots are below grade were taken into consideration in the final value estimate.
