This is a small scrap or junk yard located on a 50 x 100 foot lot at the southwest corner of Robertson and Florida Streets just one short block west of State Street. The lot has a frontage on Robertson Street east facing of 50 feet and runs between parallel lines a depth of 100 feet along Florida Street.

Robertson and Florida Streets are both dirt streets oiled. There is no sidewalk or curb, there is no sewer in either street at this location. Other improvements are in the streets.

The yard is enclosed within a part wood, part metal 8 foot wall with a swinging gate entrance on Robertson large enough to permit truck traffic.

There is one enclosed shop made of old lumber, dirt floor, no heat, 10 feet high, 20 x 30 feet with rolled roofing, and one open shed 20 x 18 used for storing used plumbing material. There is no water or plumbing in evidence.
