



Contains 4 rooms and old type bath off the kitchen. Poor plaster walls and ceilings, linoleum floors over hardwood, poor. No cabinets in the kitchen, wall sink. Rents \$40.00.

Full basement, limestone walls, dirt floor, 9 foot height. Octopus type hot air gas, 30 gallon gas water heater, no tubs or drain. Inside and outside stairs to basement.

MARKET APPROACH

Comparable Sales:

- 1. 585 Harrison. Sold \$4,700 cash, Dec. 19, 1961. Larger, 5 rooms instead of 4, only 1/2 basement but had central forced air gas heating plant and gas automatic water heater. Approximately same size lot but level & had good 2-car garage.
- 2. 46 W. Sycamore. Sold \$6,500, \$300 down, June 23, 1961.

 Small down payment indicates lower cash price. Larger, 5 rooms plus expansion attic; 2 glazed porches, full basement, gas automatic water heater, laundry and 3 year old furnace. Larger, level lot.
- 3. 88 W. Magnolia. Sold \$5,300 cash, April 12, 1960. Larger, 5 rooms. Only part basement but had central forced air gas heating and gas automatic water heater. Much larger lot, superior location.

After adjustments on these comparables and others investigated, it is felt the indicated market value of the subject property is \$3.700.00.
