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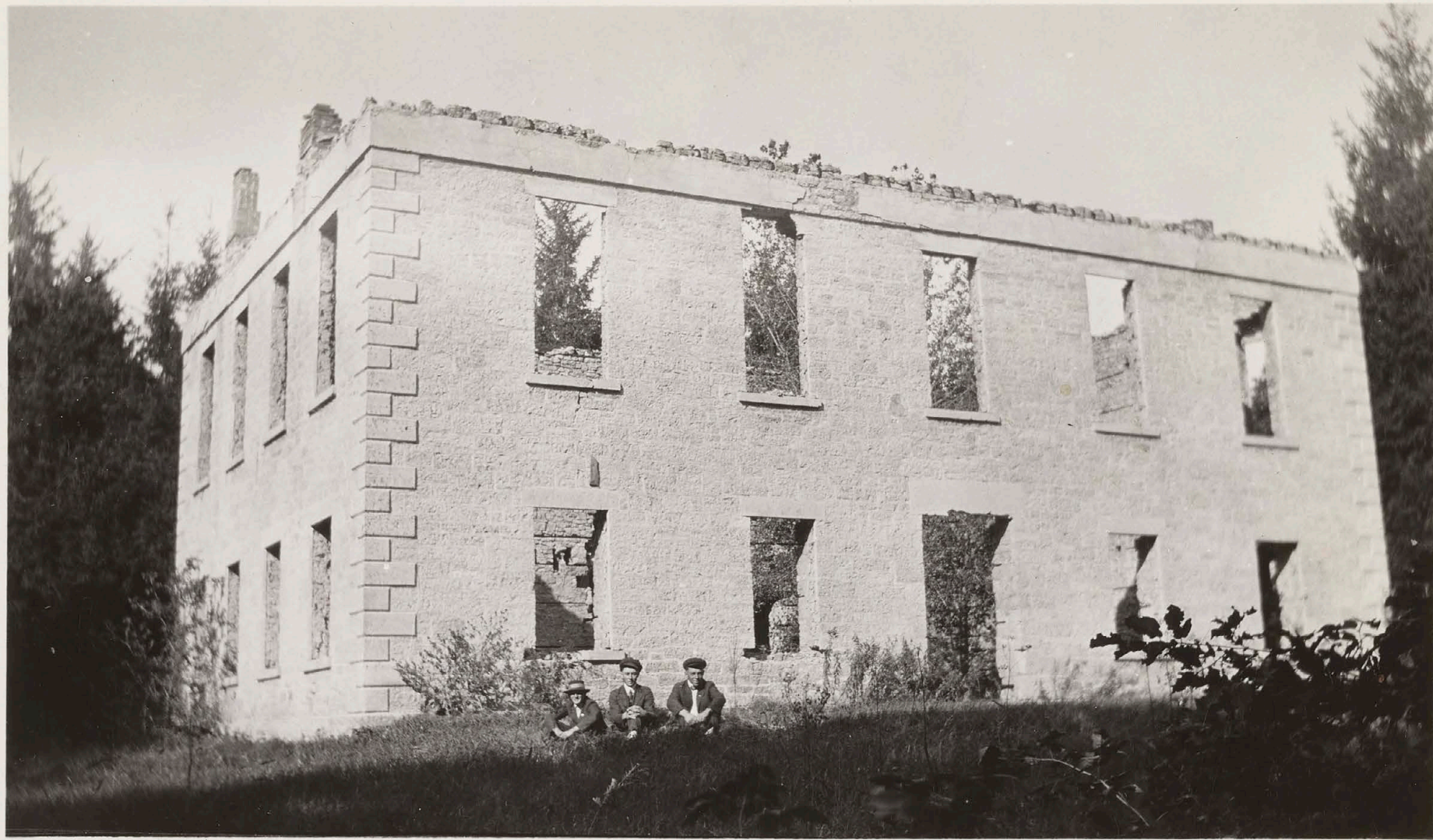

The Seminary, Wasioja, Minn.
Founded 1858 + stone walls built.
School opened by Free Will Baptists
Nov. 1. 1860 as "Minnesota Seminary"
Name changed by act Legislature
to "Northwestern College" - Spring 1861.
Free Will Baptists withdrew patronage
in 1868. Local Board leased school
to Rev. L. B. Allen, who operated it
until his death (when?) as
"Groveland Seminary".
Closed short time when sold to
Wesleyan Methodists, who
opened in 1873 as "Wesleyan
Methodist Seminary of Minn."
School closed in 1894 because of
a lack of patronage.
Building burned in 1905.
Title acquired in 1896 on
sham purchase by Rev. A. B. Gould,
former instructor and son of
Rev. J. E. Gould, treas. of Board of
Trustees.
Taxes (100) paid by widow. of A. B. G.
