Today is her last Operations meeting. Keri presented Barb with T-shirt written in X12 language for her service on AUC. Barb stated it has been an honor for her to serve on AUC (2007), formerly HCPCS. Introduced her replacement, Andrea. Andrea was welcomed as new Ops member.</p> <p>New AUC leadership will officially be recognized at March Ops meeting.</p>
5. 2013 year-end summary and review	<p>PPT shows AUC 2013 goals and accomplishments—Ongoing goals for 2014 Dave explained Results Based Accountability (RBA) – customer service survey. RBA is an MDH initiative that is required of all departments. MDH will develop and distribute customer survey to AUC to assess ROI and impact of services provided by MDH. Will solicit feedback from AUC to aid in further discussion and work with Exec to develop survey.</p> <p>Trisha asked for clarification regarding the Legislative TAG’s work for 2014. Dave reported that we worked with legislative TAG to work on non-</p>

	controversial language and to clean up 20 year-old law. MDH is unsure what will be in final legislation and thank the AUC for their work.

Current status and updates	<p>MNGCs – changes proposed for 837 P and 837 I during public comment period; CARC/RARC for Workers Comp; clarification re substance abuse code; and disclaimer statement re guarantee of payment</p> <p>Revised MCT decision tree will be reviewed by TAG. May include copy of decision tree with SBAR response</p> <p>X12 code committee decided to change all of the W codes for P for property and casualty...will be transitioned in July. Will be able to use W or P until July</p> <p>Trisha – AUC had talked about having one of the TAGs work review (asked Katherine Kmit) re 30-day grace period for premiums. X12 has a standing workgroup discuss the 30 day grace period and has made recommendation re 270/271. WEDI eligibility group is also looking at the issue of the 30-day grace period.</p>
