Forcible Entry

Cass Lake, August 11th 1933. George McKenneth came before me, and made and subscribed a written complaint, upon oath charging Fred Grabow with having on the first day of August 1933, willfully, wrongfully and unlawfully made forcible entry upon the following described lands, to-wit; W. 1/2 of N. E. 1/4 and lot 2, sec. 16. and S. W. 1/4 of S. E. 1/4, sec. 9. in Twp. 144. Rg. 31. containing 165 acres, then and there in the actual and peaceful possession of the said George McKenneth. and prayed that he be arrested. Complaint filed. Warrant issued requiring the apprehension forthwith of the said Fred Grabow. Warrant delivered to Constable Fred Applebee for service.

August 22th 1933 Warrant returned by Constable Fred Applebee with his certificate thereon, I have arrested named defendant and have him now before the court. Warrant filed.

Defendant pleaded not Guilty.

Trial set for Thursday August 17th at 10. a.m.

August 17th 1933. Court opened at 10. a.m. all present.

Defendant asked for a change of Venue, that from prejudice and other causes, he believes that Herman Abraham, the Justice of the Peace before whom said action is pending will not decide impartially in the matter.

Change of Venue granted. Affidavit for change of Venue made and filed.

all papers concerning this case taken to A. F. Cummings, a Justice of the Peace in Cass Lake, and trial is set for Monday August 28th 1933 at 10. a.m. No costs have been paid to date.

Defendant is at large without bonds.

Justice fees are 5.35. Constables fees 4.25. total \$9.60

Cass Lake, August 14th 1933. Court opened at 10 a.m.
all parties present. Ole A. Larson was sworn, he stated
that he was representing the defendant, also the state of
Minnesota, (meaning the Rural Farm Bureau Department)
as Agent. He waived all examinations. He asked the
Court to dismiss the action or allow 30 days time for a
hearing. His Grounds for dismissal were, that he ordered defendant
to move onto the premises on August first, stating that the
State was the owner and defendant to protect the Buildings.
Dismissal denied; Exhibit No 2 furnished by the Plaintiff,
dated at St. Paul, signed by T. H. Arens, (Conservator)
on the 9th day of August 1933, reads as follows: The State
has leased this property to a Mr. Grabow, who is to
receive possession on August 16th.

To grant 30 days denied. His Grounds were that it would
take him that long to get an attorney from St. Paul.

Under the circumstances the Court felt it could not grant
him that length of time.

Plaintiff stated that he put on or about May 22 some
party into the Buildings (to protect same) and this
party was on these premises when he was deposed
of them by force. Defendants Agent left the court,
everybody present followed out. Judgment against Defendant
August 17th 1933 Defendant gave notice in writing (dated
August 16th 1933) that he is taking an appeal to District Court

Appeal granted. Appeal was not taken to District Court.
County Attorney ^{ordered} me to return Exhibits to both parties.

August 14 Plaintiff and defendant made a settlement
(which stopped the writ of Restitution) by which defendant
agreed to pay Plaintiff \$2800 dollars, which was
secured by a bill of sale. On motion of defendant
the Bill of sale was made to Herman Abraham
instead of George W. Kenneth. Payment was made due
on October 14.
