## **Paideia Academy Rumor Control**

## Rumor #1: Paideia Academy is \$180,000 in debt.

False. In fact, it is quite the opposite. Our current fund balance is \$996,696 or 26.3% of our total annual expenditures. Our authorizer requires our fund balance to be at least 20% of our annual expenditures. Our treasurer and board prefer to keep the balance between 25-29%.

The state has increased the percentage of money they holdback from 27% to 30%. It has been advised by Minnesota Association of Charter Schools, Minnesota Department of Education, and our authorizer, Friends of Education, that we (and other charter schools) cut roughly 5% from our budget to help off-set this holdback. 5% equates to \$180,000. This does not mean that we owe the money, but that it may be in the next school year that we will receive it.

Because of this, the finance committee presented a document listing possible options for the board to consider. These options were not proposed or even recommended, but were presented as financial options or paths the board could choose to investigate. These options included cutting programs, changing benefits for staff, or potentially adding more students per grade level.

## Rumor #2: Paideia Academy is increasing class sizes to 24.

False. Paideia is not adding more students. This was not a proposal nor is it on the agenda for the next board meeting. If this were to occur, the board would create a committee to research the viability of such actions. Second grade is over-enrolled because of grade accelerations. If any openings in second grade should occur, we will not fill those spots.

## Rumor #3: The board is holding a secret meeting in July.

False. The board meeting is scheduled for July 21<sup>st</sup> at 7 pm as usual. There may be a board work session scheduled ahead of that. This would involve addressing board norms, board roles and responsibilities, and Roberts Rules of Order. It is against Open Meeting Law to hold a closed or a meeting without proper notice given.

## Rumor #4: Mindy Hendrickson does not have a license.

False. Mindy is a licensed teacher and is in full compliance.

If you hear any gossip or rumors, please come to me for clarification and we can stop this detrimental behavior before it starts. Please help us create the best school we can be!

## **Paideia Medication Policy**

ANY medication ("Over the Counter" or "Prescribed") administered to your child during the school day will require:

- Current school year Medication Administration Form signed by both a physician and parent/guardian.
- All medication must be brought to school by an adult and must be in its original Container, un-opened if of the Over the Counter type.
- Parents are responsible for contacting the office if medication/dosage changes.
- Medication will be kept in locked cabinet and administered by designated staff.

Bring this form along with meds to the nurse's table at Back to School Night

At no time should a student have medication on them or in their backpack! This includes over the counter meds such as Tylenol, cough syrup, etc...






