DISMISSAL PROCEDURE

- 1. All students are to be picked up at the South side. (Please see the attached map.) We will be following the designated traffic pattern by entering the on the Southeast side of Bogart's. Using the first Garret. Ave entrance is strictly prohibited. All traffic will follow along to the South side of Paideia. Please have your numbers displayed clearly.
- 2. At the corner, we will make two lines of traffic. Please fill up one line completely, then, when prompted by the traffic director, create the second outside row. This will allow us to dismiss 18 cars at a time. Once the first row of cars is full and has completely exited, the second row will be filled. **NO CARS ARE ALLOWED TO PULL OUT BEFORE THE CAR IN FRONT OF THEM.**
- 3. Cars will exit around the Paideia building and then make a RIGHT TURN ONLY onto 147th Street. Please be aware of the Safety Patrol Officers stationed by the (West) entrance. They will be monitoring the crosswalk. All parents/guardians parking and picking up their children early from school but after 3:15 pm should park in the West lot and use the gym door.

Indoor Dismissal: Students are dismissed at 3:30 p.m. Students must be picked up between 3:30-3:50 pm, unless participating in a supervised, Academy related program. Only individuals listed on the EMERGENCY CONTACT card will be allowed to pickup students from the Academy. Valid photo identification will be required of all individuals picking up students. If someone arrives at the Academy to seek the release of a student and the person's name is not on the emergency contact card the student, by law, cannot be released. Parents must park at the West side of the building and enter through the northwest gym doors.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

Entrance/Exits/Parking: The Southeast entrance serves as the main entrance to Paideia Academy. This door is only accessible during Academy hours and is monitored at all times. All students must enter and exit the building using the entrance at the southeast corner of the building. Morning drop off is between 7:55 am and 8:15 am and afternoon pick up is between 3:30 pm -3:50 pm. Students may not be dropped off earlier than 7:55 or picked up later than 3:50 pm.

The South curb and West curbs are reserved for drop off and pick up. There shall be **no** parking along these curbs at any time.

Drop Off: Vehicles must enter the parking lot from the East side of the building off of Garrett where staff/parent volunteers will monitor students entering the Academy. It is not necessary for students to wait for staff/parent volunteers to open the car doors.

Parents are to remain in their vehicles. If your student needs assistance exiting the vehicle, you are to park on the SE side of the building and walk them in.

It is imperative that cars do NOT pull out and around cars as this creates a huge safety risk. Please wait for the car in front of you to pull away. NO student should be dropped off or picked up at any location other than the curb unless the parent is parking in the west lot and accompanying the child(ren) into the building.





Paideia SCRIP Program - Painless Fund Raising!

What is SCRIP?

SCRIP is a gift card program offered by national and local retailers that work with non-profit organizations. The gift cards that you purchase through the **Paideia SCRIP Program** gives you the opportunity to purchase the cards <u>at face value</u>. With no cost to you, Paideia will receive a small percentage of your card purchase directly back from the companies listed in the SCRIP program.

How can you get Gift Cards?

- 1. You can place a paper order by using the SCRIP order form, which will also be available in Friday newsletters or in the office. **Payment and forms are due every second and fourth Mondays of the month by 9am, which also includes online orders.** In doing this, orders can be placed on Monday and returned to your student as soon as possible.
- 2 . You can place an order online at www.shopwithscrip.com. If you are a new user, please create a new account in the GREEN box using Paideia's enrollment code, EAAC1D2C18284. Existing families can just log in the ORANGE member's box. Orders can be placed at any time with payment sent to the office or paid though Presto Pay on the shop with scrip website.
- 3. AVAILABLE NOW! A limited inventory of SCRIP gift cards will be for sale in the office, at Monday morning meetings, and at PIE and Board meetings. Cash is accepted, but **checks are preferred**, so don't forget to bring your checkbook!
