Organics recycling begins Monday, October 25!

What is organics recycling? It means that we are separating out items that can break down naturally and become compost. We will be sending them to a commercial composting facility, which means that we can recycle more materials than you can in a backyard compost bin.

Items that go in organics recycling include:

- Food waste (including meat products)
- Paper napkins, bags, cups, plates, and wrappers
- Compostable trays and flatware
- Milk cartons

We will also be offering expanded plastics recycling capabilities for items such as plastic pods, yogurt cups, and more.


