The City of Apple Valley is excited to sponsor the Paideia Academy Recycling Poster Contest! The Contest promotes the enhanced recycling program at Paideia Academy and is available to all K-8th Grade students.

The theme for the 2010 Recycling Poster Contest is **“Know What Goes Where”**. Posters should reflect the awareness of recycling and the importance of identifying what can and cannot be recycled or composted.

Prizes will be awarded to the “Best Overall” (three winners, one each for K-2, 3-5, 6-8); “Most Creative”, “Best Use of Color”; and 9 Honorable Mention posters.

Rules To Enter

- ☐ The message **must** reflect the awareness of recycling and the importance of identifying what can and cannot be recycled or composted. Any one or all of these may be a part of your poster.
- ☐ Posters must be on **11” by 17” or larger poster board or construction paper**. Notebook paper is not acceptable.
- ☐ **Colors should be bold and bright**. Crayons, permanent markers, or paint is recommended.
- ☐ We cannot select as a winner any posters, which include brand names or cartoon, television, or movie characters due to copyright. Designs traced from coloring books or other pictures cannot be accepted as original drawings.
- ☐ The student’s name, home address, home phone number, name of school, grade and teacher **must be clearly printed on the backside of the poster**. Posters without complete identifying information on the backside will NOT be accepted for judging. **Use the label below for proper identification.**
- The final judging committee is organized by the City of Apple Valley. Posters will be judged based on: **Originality, Artwork, Correct Spelling and Effective Message.**
- **Deadline:** Please submit posters to the Paideia Academy school office no later than **3:30 p.m. on Friday, November 5, 2010.**
- An awards ceremony will be held mid-November 2010.
