I trust that you are having a lovely summer so far! I'm glad that it's finally warm (albeit really

hot!) and not so rainy.

A few updates from the office that I wanted to communicate:

The next **DEC meeting** is tentatively scheduled for July 18 7-8:30 in the small commons.

The committee is working on securing a representative from an anti-bullying curriculum

called Olweus. If the meeting is cancelled it will be posted on the website.

**Monday morning meeting** is a great opportunity to build community at Paideia and start the week off on the right foot. In the past, it has also been a vehicle for parent/guardian communication as well, which is good but certainly not optimal since not

all parents/guardians are able to be in attendance. Hence we have been including all the

information that is announced at morning meeting in the weekly newsletter to ensure that

all families have access to the same information.

Next year, morning meetings are tentatively scheduled as such:

K-8 meetings all together in the large commons once every 3-4 weeks on the following

dates:

Quarter 1 Aug 8 (first day)

Aug 29 (kick off for Innisbrook fundraiser)

Sept 26 (last Monday of month)

Quarter 2 Oct 24 (first Mon back from long break) Nov 28 (Monday after Tday weekend)

Quarter 3 Jan 23 (first Mon back after the MLK weekend, after long break) Feb 27 (last Mon of Feb)

Quarter 4 April 9 (first Mon back from long break)
May 7 (first Mon of month)
June 11 (last Mon of school year)

The remaining Monday morning meetings will be held separately **K-5 in the small commons** led by Mr. Hondl and **6-8 middle school in the gym** lead by Mr. Holm simultaneously from 8:15-8:30AM. In discussions with the staff and PIE reps, it was nearly

unanimous to move to this model in order to make the time the most meaningful, developmentally appropriate, and time conscious.

"Hondl's Heroes" will be called "Paideia Peeps". The staff voted to add 5 new character

**traits** to the existing P.R.I.D.E. as R.E.A.C.H. and the rotation of traits will be a monthly (rather than weekly) focus based on the following:

We will focus on all the characteristics of **P.R.I.D.E.** and **R.E.A.C.H.** for the month of June.

New Family Orientation Night will be held on July 18 from 5-6:30PM in the large commons. This will be in addition to the Back To School Night on August 3 in the hopes of alleviating the feeling of being overwhelmed (new families) at the larger Back To School Night. New Family Orientation Night is for adults only.

Paideia's school day will end an hour early <u>every</u> Wednesday for staff collaboration time.


# Lunch Update:
