A Message From Ms. Nufer, Technology Integration Specialist

A middle school student, who shall remain nameless, came up to me in the hall the other day and said, "What do you do now, anyway?" Good question! This is our very first year having a Technology Integration Specialist at Paideia Academy. The goal of this position is to provide teachers with resources, training and ideas to incorporate more technology into the curriculum. As difficult as it was to choose to leave the science classroom, I am very excited about helping teachers use technology to teach! Critical to our vision of creating engaged, productive global citizens is making sure students are comfortable with and are well versed in technology before we send them on to high school. By providing students with exposure to technology in computer class as well as core subjects and specials, we can help students engage meaningfully with the content while becoming proficient at software and other applications.

Other components of my new position include supporting teachers in their Data Driven Instruction efforts. Teachers must write, upload, deliver and analyze their DDI assessments on a quarterly basis. I also work with the Special Education department to procure and implement assistive technology when students require it. I also handle Schoolview setup requests, the grade book and report cards and scheduling for students in our student information system, TIES. I work with Ms. Gillingham on MCA and MAP testing's technical side, provide training for teachers in a variety of software and web based applications and troubleshoot and fix technology-related issues as they arise. My favorite part of this position, however, is assisting teachers in designing and delivering

lessons incorporating technology; I love being in the classroom and watching the students become engaged when technology is used!

Paideia is very lucky; we have a dedicated, caring parent base committed to raising funds for a variety of projects throughout the school. Thanks to the efforts of PIE and the Fundraising Committee, we now have a SmartBoard for each grade level (K-5), a SmartBoard in the Spanish room, one in the 7/8 Math room, one in the 7/8 Science room and one in the 6th grade Math/Science room for a grand total of ten SmartBoards! SmartBoards use touch recognition (the same way an ipad or ipod touch works) to allow students to interact with the content on the board. If you have never seen a SmartBoard in action, please check out this three-minute video: http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0U05WeXPGlk and plan on attending PIE's Technology Night on December 5th at 6:30 pm. We will be showcasing all the technology we have here at Paideia including SmartBoards, SmartResponders, document cameras, our computer lab and COW computers as well as some of the web based applications and software we use with the students. We'd really love to see you there!
