
Paideia's Head Lice Policy:

Students will be checked periodically for head lice. Students will be sent home if Academy personnel suspect lice in a students hair. All parents/guardians will be notified in the event of a case of head lice. Students **MAY NOT** return to the Academy until treatment has been administered and all nits have been removed from the hair. Upon returning to the Academy, the student will be checked to determine if any nits are still present before admission to class.

The Minnesota Department of Health makes the following recommendations to schools concerning head lice: School districts should make their own policies on whether or not to do "head checks" at school. Parents should not rely on school staff to check for lice but should do this at home, whether or not the children are checked at school.
