DDI Testing: Next Week!

Grades K-5: Students will be taking Quarter 3 DDI math assessments between March 1 – March 9. Assessments usually take about 45 minutes to complete. Data is used to drive and improve instruction, assess student achievement of state standards, and allow for opportunities for re-teaching if necessary.

Grades 6-8: Students will be taking Quarter 3 DDI math, social studies, language arts, and science assessments between March 1 – March 9. Assessments usually take about 60 minutes to complete. Data is used drive and improve instruction, assess student achievement of state standards, and allow for opportunities for re-teaching if necessary.

Project Nicaragua

I am excited to introduce Project Nicaragua, a service project organized by Paideia Academy Spanish students. Educator and social entrepreneur Kristi Hemmer is working to promote literacy in Esteli, Nicaragua. Children have limited access to literature in remote communities like Esteli and Ms. Hemmer is working with community members to develop a bookmobile program that will provide reading materials to women and children.

The students in an advanced placement 8th grade independent study have partnered with Ms. Hemmer to develop Project Nicaragua, a service project that will help collect Spanish literature for the bookmobile. The students have worked to develop a website, coordinate a Lower Academy and Upper Academy book drive that will begin March 5, and a Family Night presentation on Nicaragua.
