

## Paideia PTO

#### Fellow Paideia Families -

I would like to take this time to tell you a little bit about our newly formed **PTO** (Parent Teacher Organization) and how it came into effect. Our former parent group (PIE) felt it was time to restructure their organization and decided the best way to do this would be to form a PTO. With PTO being formed, our goal is for more parent involvement, new ideas, transparency and a team approach to working with the teachers, the school board and administration. Thank you to those that have already volunteered for positions to finish the school year, and to start up 2012 - 2013. For those of you that have not signed up, and are interested in investing in the success of parent organization and students, I would like to share some ways that you may consider becoming involved the rest of the year, or for next year.

Our PTO is made up of 6 Teams: Fundraising, Communications, Volunteers, Student Enrichment, Family Programs and Support of Operations. Over the next few newsletters I will describe these teams in a bit more detail.

#### **FUNDRAISING**

The Fundraising team is the foundation to the PTO. **100% of the money raised goes directly back to Paideia Academy.** We support administration and assist in purchasing needed items, we support the staff and students through class supplies, events and other needs. Our focus is the students and assisting the staff in supporting their successful education.

The Fundraising team has many ways to get involved; *Sponsorship and Donations, Dining out, Rebates, Grant writing, Plant Sale, Field Trip Funding, Trivia Night*. Each of these areas has a lead who is responsible for organizing the group and activities with other volunteers.

The priority of the Fundraising Team is to do as much painless fundraising as possible. By doing this, it will enable you to give back while doing the things you would normally do. (ie - purchase gift cards, save box tops, milk tops, Coke Tops, etc., go out to eat with your family and encouraging a social setting to allow you to get to know other Paideia parents)

We have a couple of fundraisers going on the remainder of the year. The first is <u>Bachman's Gift Card Sale</u>. When you you purchase a Bachman's gift card (\$25-\$500), 15% of your total comes back to assist us in funding PTO student projects and events. <u>Trivia Night</u> is another great way to get out for the evening, meet other Paideia families, and have a great time. This event is a popular fundraiser for many schools and we are excited to be hosting it, along with a Silent Auction on June 2<sup>nd</sup>.
