The Paideia Academy PTO is so excited to be able to offer many ways to get your involved in your child's education. Last week I talked about how the PTO will support the students and the school in *Fundraising*. This week I wanted to talk about *Volunteering*.

The Volunteers team has a **coordinator** (this position is open for next school year) which is a part of the PTO's Executive Board. The Coordinator supports his or her team; **Volunteer Database Lead, Room Parent Lead, Book Fair Lead, Spirit Wear Lead and Special area request lead**. Each leader is responsible for becoming the contact person to arrange the volunteers throughout the school year. Much of this work can be done at home and via e mails. The Volunteer Team is a great way to meet other Paideia Parents.

Paideia Academy is a special and unique school. One way in which we are unique is that we truly want the parents involved in the students' education. We encourage volunteerism; we depend on it. This year we have close to 5,000 documented volunteer hours. That is equal to about 2.5 full time employees! This saves the school thousands of dollars that can go back to the children's education and also allows you to be an active member of the community!

We strongly encourage the families to give 50 hours per year of their time, not just because we need it but because we want you to be involved; it is so important to your students education in a number of ways!
