Dear Paideia Parents,

The PTO is very excited to be sponsoring the **2nd Annual 5K Run** / **Walk next weekend**, **June 2**nd! Thank you to all of you who have already signed up!

It is <u>very easy</u> to get involved in the PTO, with <u>so much of the work that can be done from home!</u> We have an executive committee that is made up of 3 teachers representing all grade levels, the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. The other 6 positions are held by the Team Coordinators of each group: Fundraising, Communications, Volunteers, Student Enrichment, Family Programs, and Support of Operations. These 13 people represent the Paideia PTO Executive Board and are the *only members required to attend monthly meetings*. All other team leads (ie. grant writing, newsletter, honor roll, etc.) are not required to attend monthly meetings, but are encouraged to meet with other leads within their team.

The **Student Enrichment Team** has open positions in the areas of **Arts in Education, Academic Enrichment, High School Information Night and Student Assemblies.** The leads in these areas will have a budget to work with, and will work with staff and PTO to assist in organizing events for the students. Most of this work is communication and planning (easy to do from home!). Volunteering at the actual event would be the only volunteer time away from home. The sky's the limit to think of ways to enrich the students. If you feel you have an interest in any of these lead positions, please let us know. We are also looking for a Coordinator for this team.

The *Family Programs Team* has other areas to get involved, again most of it is at home doing communication and planning. Leads are needed in the areas of **General Programs, Parent Education, Student Dance and Family Fun**. Again, each Lead will have a budget to work with to plan fun events with the PTO and Administration.
