Dear Paideia Families,

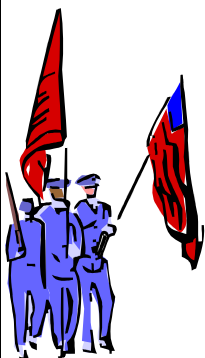

## Join Paideia Academy in the Apple Valley Freedom Days Parade on July 4<sup>th</sup>!

Paideia Academy has applied to participate in the very popular and festive Freedom Days Parade! We are looking for volunteers to help **decorate** a patriotic float and/or to **participate** in the parade itself.

### Here is what we currently need:

Trailer: If you have a trailer, please let us know!

Volunteers needed for decorating: We will need some volunteers to decorate the float the night prior to the parade (July 3<sup>rd</sup>). If you have experience decorating floats, we want to hear from you!

Volunteers needed for participating: The parade route is 1 mile long, and in an effort to keep the pace of the parade moving forward, Apple Valley has set the following guidelines: Children under

the age of 12 must ride on the float. We are allowed only 12 walking members and they must be 12 years of age or older. Children in strollers are not allowed. No one is permitted to wear rollerblades.

The parade starts at 1 p.m. Volunteers must show up at 12:15 p.m. to the staging area and be prepared for the weather conditions! Parents should wear red or white tops with blue jeans or jean shorts. Students should wear red Paideia spirit wear shirts (or a red or white shirt), and jeans or jean shorts. 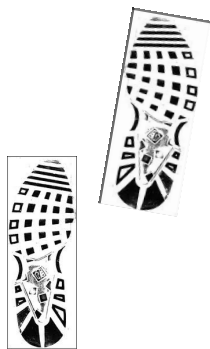
