From the Director

Dear Paideia Community,

Hello families! Education is once again a big topic in the news due to the Minnesota Department of Education's release of schools' Multiple Measures Ratings (MMR). These ratings evaluate schools based on three criteria:

- Proficiency Did the school meet the targets set for it by the State regarding the percentage of students in each subgroup expected to demonstrate proficiency on the MCA math and reading tests?
- ♦ Growth Did individual students make more progress than expected (based on statewide averages) on MCA tests from year-to-year?
- Achievement Gap Reduction How does the growth of students in certain subgroups compare to the growth of students in traditionally higher-performing subgroups at the school? (*Subgroups are based on race, special education status, limited English proficiency, and free/reduced price lunch)

Paideia Academy earned a total MMR score of <u>74.86%</u> for the 2011-2012 school year. Our percentile ranks (where we stand compared to other schools in MN) are as follows:

- ♦ Proficiency 99th percentile
- ♦ Growth 72nd percentile
- ♦ Achievement Ġap Reduction 52nd percentile (If you are interested, you can find more detailed information about our school's data at http://education.state.mn.us/MDEAnalytics/Reports.jsp

It is *fabulous* that so many of our students are proficient in reading and math! I applaud the efforts of the staff at school and the work you have done at home with your children to prepare them with foundational knowledge and skills. We still have a way to go, however, to reach our goal of being the top academic-performing school in Dakota County, especially in terms of our Growth and Achievement Gap Reduction.

We are working to address these areas in a number of ways here at Paideia. First, our Data-Driven Instruction model is designed to support teachers to assess individual student learning strengths and needs, then develop instructional strategies to support groups and individuals in a more targeted fashion. Second, our observation process is designed to support teachers to develop systems for instruction and assessment within and across grade levels that will help them address the strengths and needs of our diverse student body.

Third, our weekly collaborative planning sessions provide opportunities for teachers to learn with and from each other, to share best practices, and to engage in activities to support cohesion schoolwide. Lastly, we are placing a strong emphasis on our co-teaching model and supporting teachers to develop differentiated action plans to appropriately challenge students at all levels.

Paideia is truly a great place to be! There are already amazing things being done here, and it is clear that the entire community is invested in supporting our continued and greater success. Thank you for your encouragement and collaborative spirit. Enjoy the next four days with your families.

August 21, 2012 Board Meeting Highlights

- Paideia survived the 2011-2012 school year in outstanding financial shape without having to tap into any additional resources or loans. Paideia weathered the State shut-down and increased holdbacks of school funds in large part because the school conserved its transportation funds over the years through the option for families to wave transportation rights. These funds also allowed Paideia to invest in SmartBoards for every classroom, new computers, iPads, at the end of the 2011-2012 school year.
- Current enrollment is 386 students. We have spots to fill in Upper Academy, and need the help of our families to spread the word and increase our school's visibility.
- ♦ Results are in Paideia met Annual Yearly Progress (AYP) in all areas and subgroups!
- Arrival and dismissal procedures are going well; we are out most days by 3:45, and student safety continues to be the main focus.
- There is one vacant spot on the School Board; this spot will be filled through a nomination, presentation, and majority vote at the September board meeting.
- Next steps: determining steps for how Paideia can meet the strategic vision set forth by the board, communicating MCA results to individual families, examining curriculum and assessment practices in relation to student achievement, and developing an updated teacher evaluation and compensation package.

The next board meeting is Wednesday, September 19th at 7:00. We welcome all families to attend!

Nominations will open on Monday, August 27th and close on Friday, September 7th at 5:00pm.




Carnival - Mark your Calendars!


Fundraising
