From the Director

Dear Paideia Community,

Hello! It's starting to feel like fall as we near the end of our first quarter. As much as I've enjoyed my first summer here, I'm also excited to experience my favorite season (fall) in Minnesota. As we move into this next phase of our school year, I'd like to share with you some of our current and upcoming programs/activities designed to support our community as well as share some of the work we are doing to help us fulfill our school's mission and vision.

Olweus Anti-Bullying Program - At our September 17th Monday Morning Meeting, we will be holding our kick-off meeting to officially introduce the Olweus Anti-Bullying Program to the Paideia community. This program is designed to support our staff and students to discuss the who, what, where, why, and when of bullying and other inappropriate behaviors. That same evening (Monday, 9/17/12 at 7:00pm), our Olweus representative will present a workshop specifically designed for families to help you understand the program and how you can support our efforts. We look forward to seeing you at one or both of the events on Monday!

Monday Morning Meetings for Upper Academy – Monday Morning Meetings will be redesigned for Upper Academy students for at least the second quarter. Rather than meeting as a whole group with parents, students will be divided into smaller groups to work with staff to concentrate on improving our communication and conflict resolution skills. Our intention is to give our Upper Academy students more voice in the community and to support their character development.

Family Conferences – Next Thursday and Friday, teachers will be leading conferences with families to discuss your child's progress and performance. This week, during our Wednesday collaborative planning session, we reviewed individual students' MCA data reports (4th-8th grades) so teachers would be prepared to discuss the intricacies of them, as well as how the data connect to what they are seeing in class, with you during conferences. Lower Academy teachers will be discussing the data collected from MAP testing and other assessments. Our school's data (MCA tests, MMR results, etc.) demonstrate that we are a great school making huge strides (10% growth on schoolwide MCA math scores last year!), and that we have specific areas for improvement. We are excited about continuing our work together to support your children individually and collectively.

Teacher Observations – Ashley Gillingham, Lynda Cavanaugh, and I have been implementing our system for observations during the past few weeks, and we will have officially observed each teacher by the end of the first quarter. I am happy to say that I have been thoroughly impressed by what I've seen in our classrooms and the thoughtful planning and preparation teachers have put in to meet the various needs of our students. These observations have also helped me recognize our need to improve our consistency within and across grade levels, and we are devoting resources to doing so throughout the year and into next summer. This process has allowed us to have stimulating conversations about classroom teaching and learning, school-wide systems, and professional development. I have already seen improvements being made based on these conversations, and I am looking forward to see what is yet to come.

I encourage your continued participation at Paideia, particularly by becoming an active member of the PTO. I see great strength in this organization, and I anticipate that not only the families, but also the students and staff of Paideia will benefit greatly from a strong, cohesive PTO.


