Our newest members of the National Junior Honor Society will be inducted into the program during a ceremony on Thursday night. Big thanks go out to all of the staff who have played a role in planning this event, reading applications, interviewing student applicants, and choosing new members!

On Friday, our Authorizer, Friends of Education, will be conducting their official site visit of Paideia Academy. During this visit, a representative will meet with members of the administration, office staff, and teaching staff, as well as tour the school and visit classrooms. We are looking forward to receiving feedback from the visit to support us in meeting our charter goals.

During the first two weeks of March, the National Junior Honor Society conducted a fundraiser for We Act, which is an organization that seeks to bring about social change through shifting the "Me Generation" into the "We Generation." With a philosophy of "Think globally, act locally," the organization engages young people through many facets. It seeks to provide impoverished families around the world (including those in our own neighborhoods) with food/water security, access to affordable health care, and exposure to quality educational settings. Our NJHS team immediately migrated toward the issue of food

insecurity and has been educating themselves on how something so simple, such as a family owning a goat, can start to change peoples' life situations. NJHS set a goal for raising enough to purchase five goats at \$50 each. Altogether, Paideia Academy raised a collective total of \$1013.44, which will now allow We Act to purchase 20 goats and donate them to families in need. For bringing in the most pennies:
