NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON LAND EXCHANGE

A public hearing will be held at the DNR Building, 500 Lafayette Road, 4th floor EAST Conference Room, St. Paul, Minnesota on April 29, 1991, at 9:00 a.m., to consider a proposed land exchange of certain Class A land belonging to the State of Minnesota situated in the Counties of Itasca, Cook, Cass and St. Louis.

A public hearing will be held at the County Court House, Commissioner's Room, Bagley, Minnesota on April 25, 1991, at 1:00 p.m., to consider a proposed land exchange of certain Class A land belonging to the State of Minnesota situated in the Counties of Clearwater and Becker.

This exchange involves 3,937 acres of DNR Forestry Managed Permanent School Trust Fund land valued at \$1,100,400. The Trust land will be exchanged with DNR Forestry Managed Acquired State land of equal value selected from the attached list. If completed, this exchange will remove trust lands from within state parks boundaries to be managed for timber or other revenue generating uses outside the park boundaries.

In the event that you wish to comment on the exchange, but are not able to attend the hearing, you may write directly to the Bureau of Real Estate Management, Acquisition and Exchange Section at the above address. Your comments will be read at the hearing and made part of the official transcript.

Following this hearing, a recommendation will be made to the Land Exchange Board concerning completion of this exchange.

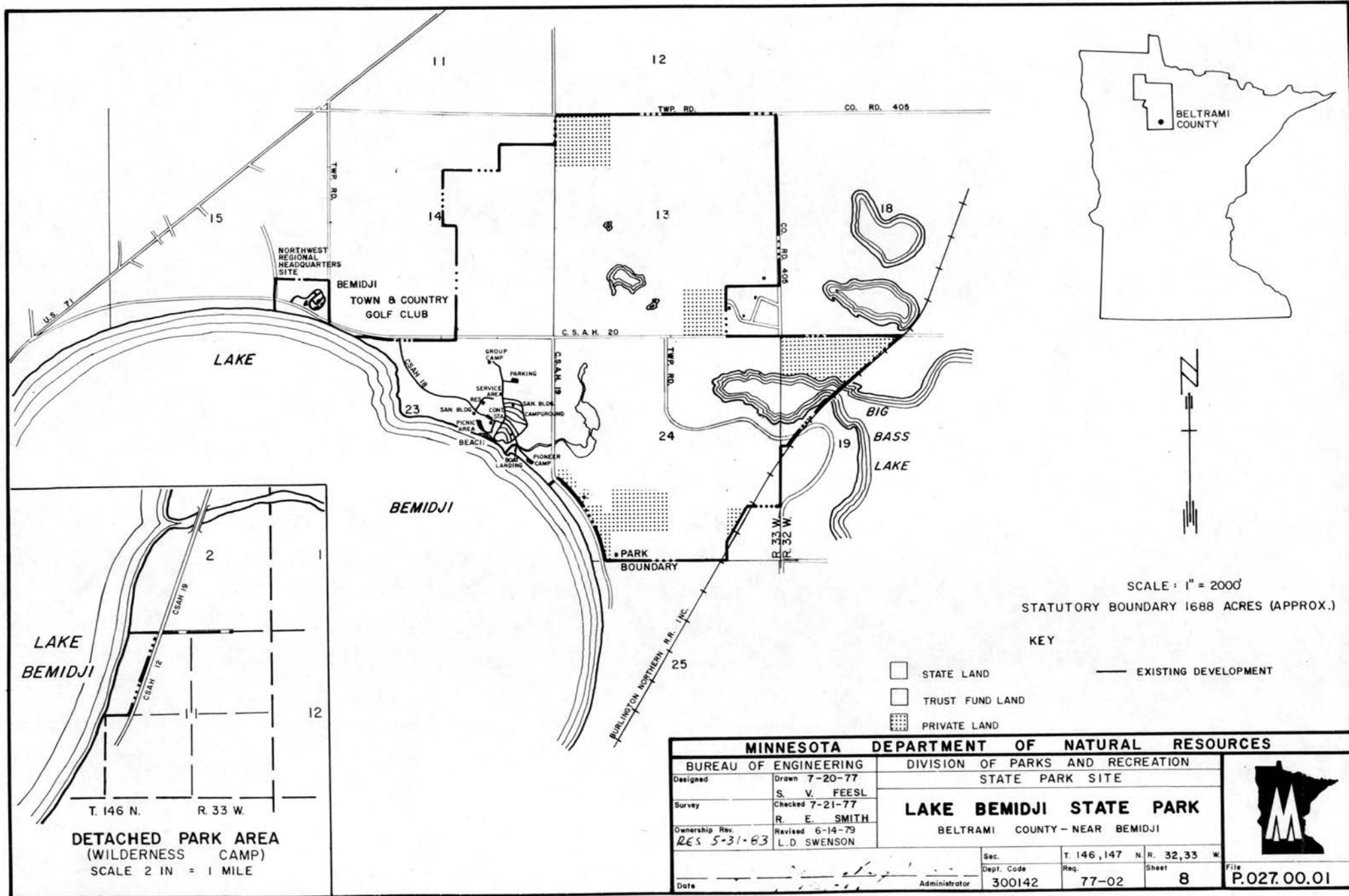

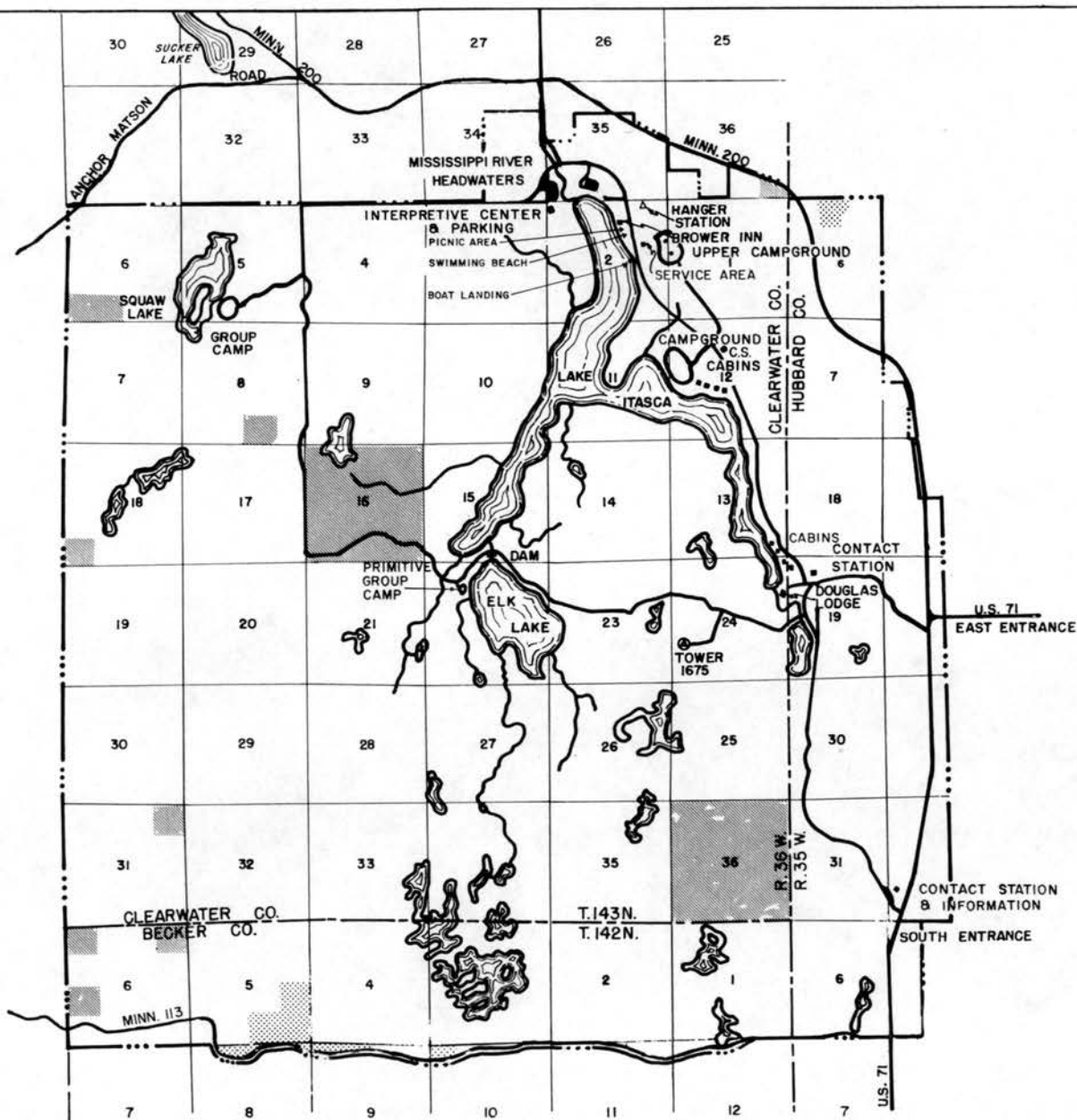

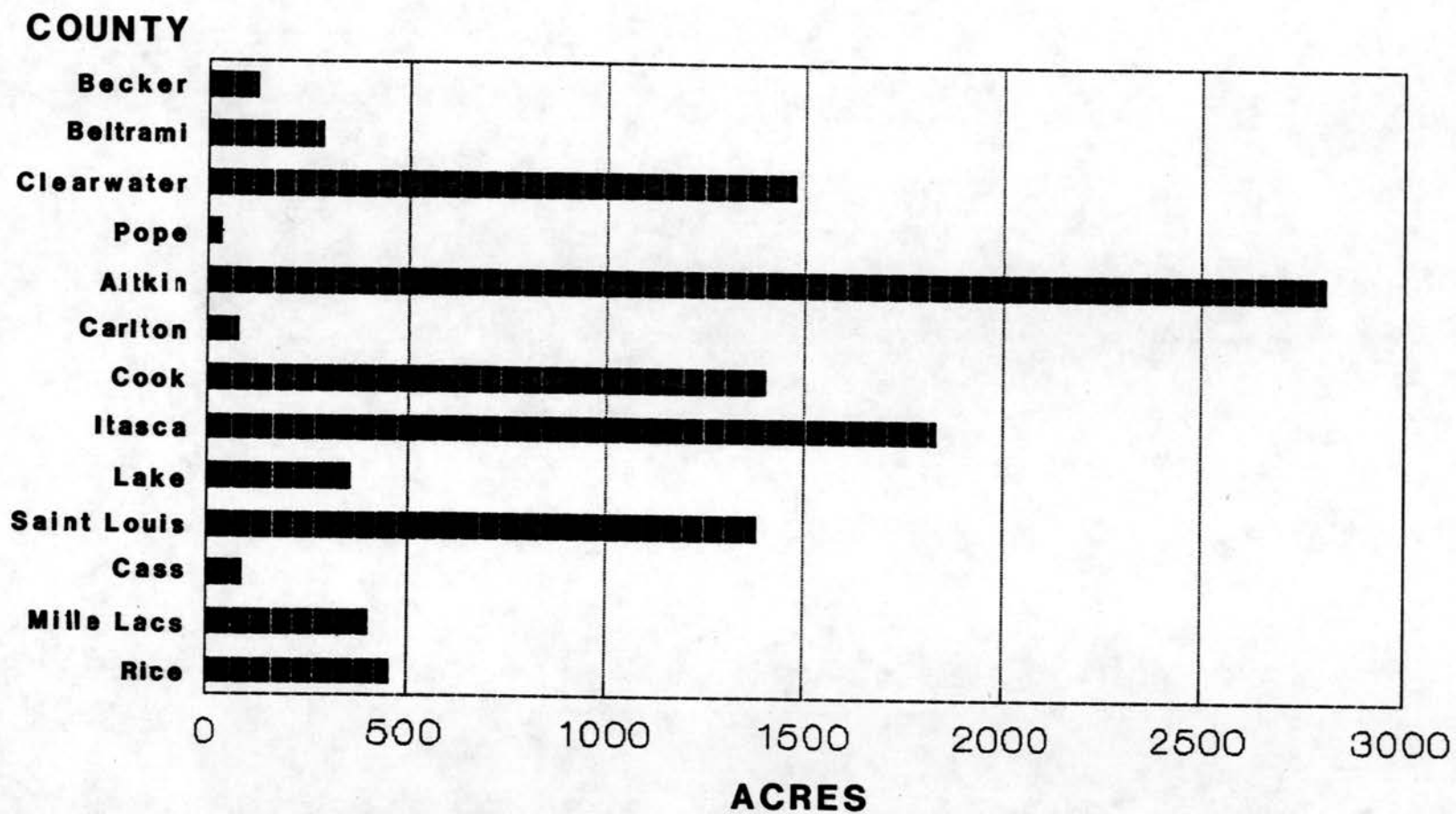

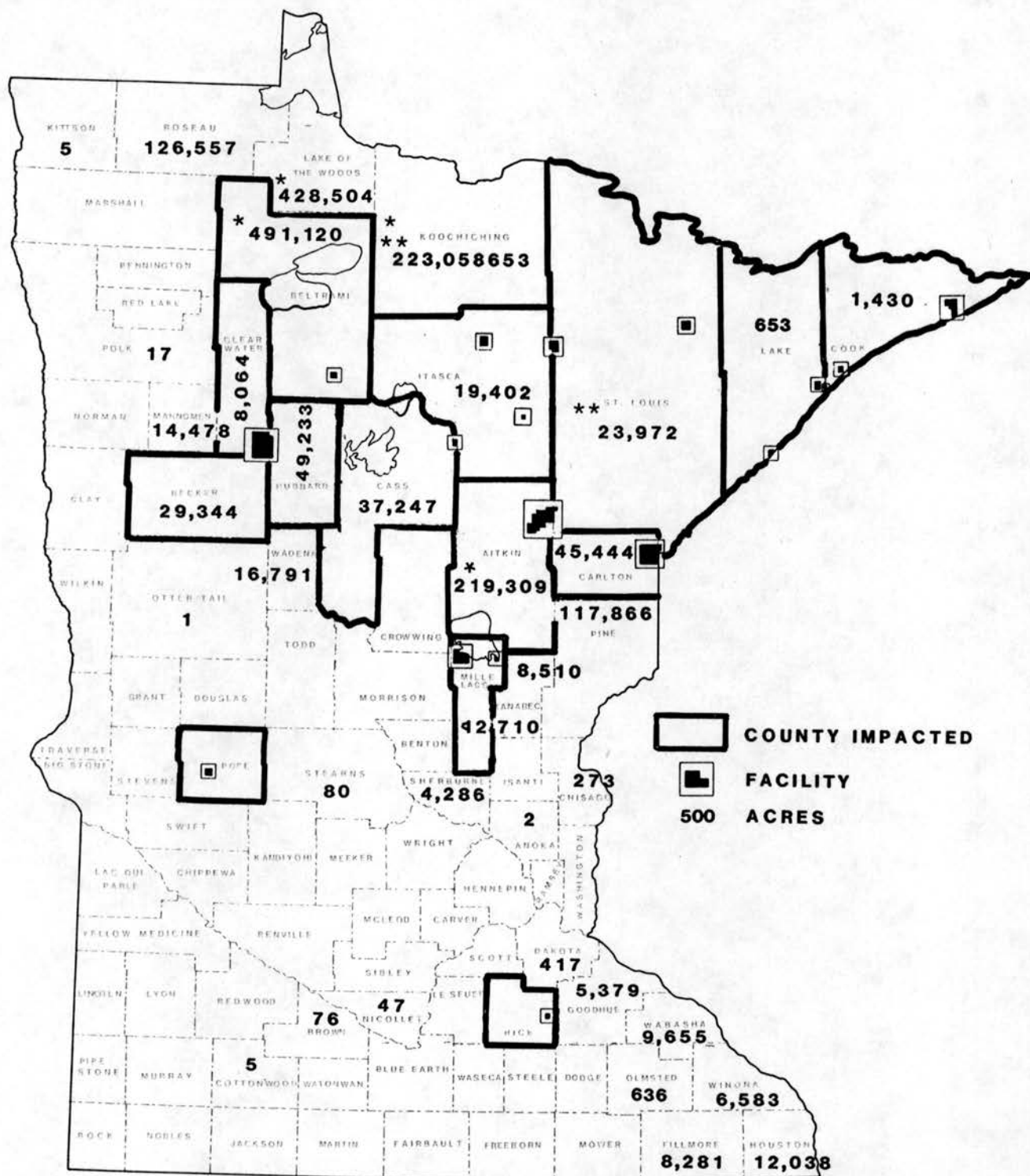

22 Starting at the corner common to Sections 17, 16, 20 and
23 21, Township 56 North, Range 23 West; thence due east on section

25 thence due north 330 feet; thence due west 916 feet; thence due
26 south 330 feet to the point of beginning.

27 Sec. 3. [ACQUISITION.]

28 When the agreements and transfers required by section 4
29 have been completed to the satisfaction of the commissioner of
30 natural resources, the commissioner shall acquire by
31 condemnation sufficient ownership interests in the surface
32 estate of the land described in section 2 to create a state park
33 to interpret and provide the public with an opportunity to view
34 and experience natural iron ore open-pit mining operations as

36 The commissioner may not condemn the mineral estate in the
37 described property, and, in the establishment of the park, shall

6 Sec. 4. [ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE.]

7 For establishing Hill-Annex Mine state park, the iron range
8 resources and rehabilitation board must take the following
9 actions:

10 (1) the board must provide the commissioner of natural
11 resources with the necessary equipment to operate the Hill-Annex
12 Mine state park and maintain the access roads for the Hill-Annex
13 Mine tour, provide the commissioner of natural resources with an
14 agreement by local units of government to maintain the access
15 roads for the Hill-Annex Mine tour, or must enter into an
16 agreement with the department of natural resources to maintain
17 these roads at the expense of the board;

18 (2) the board must acquire and install a water pump and
19 necessary pipeline for dewatering the mine that is of sufficient
20 capacity to efficiently maintain a water level low enough to
21 allow public bus tours down to the bottom of A pocket; and

22 (3) the board must provide vehicles suitable for
23 transporting visitors through the mine on interpretive tours.

24 Sec. 5. [APPROPRIATION.]

25 \$270,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the
26 commissioner of natural resources to operate Hill-Annex Mine
27 state park for fiscal year 1989.

28 \$160,000 is appropriated to the commissioner of natural
29 resources from the general fund for land acquisition to be
30 available until expended.

31 Five positions are added to the complement of the division
32 of parks and recreation for staff for Hill-Annex Mine state
33 park."

34 And when so amended that the bill be recommended to pass
35 and be referred to the full committee.

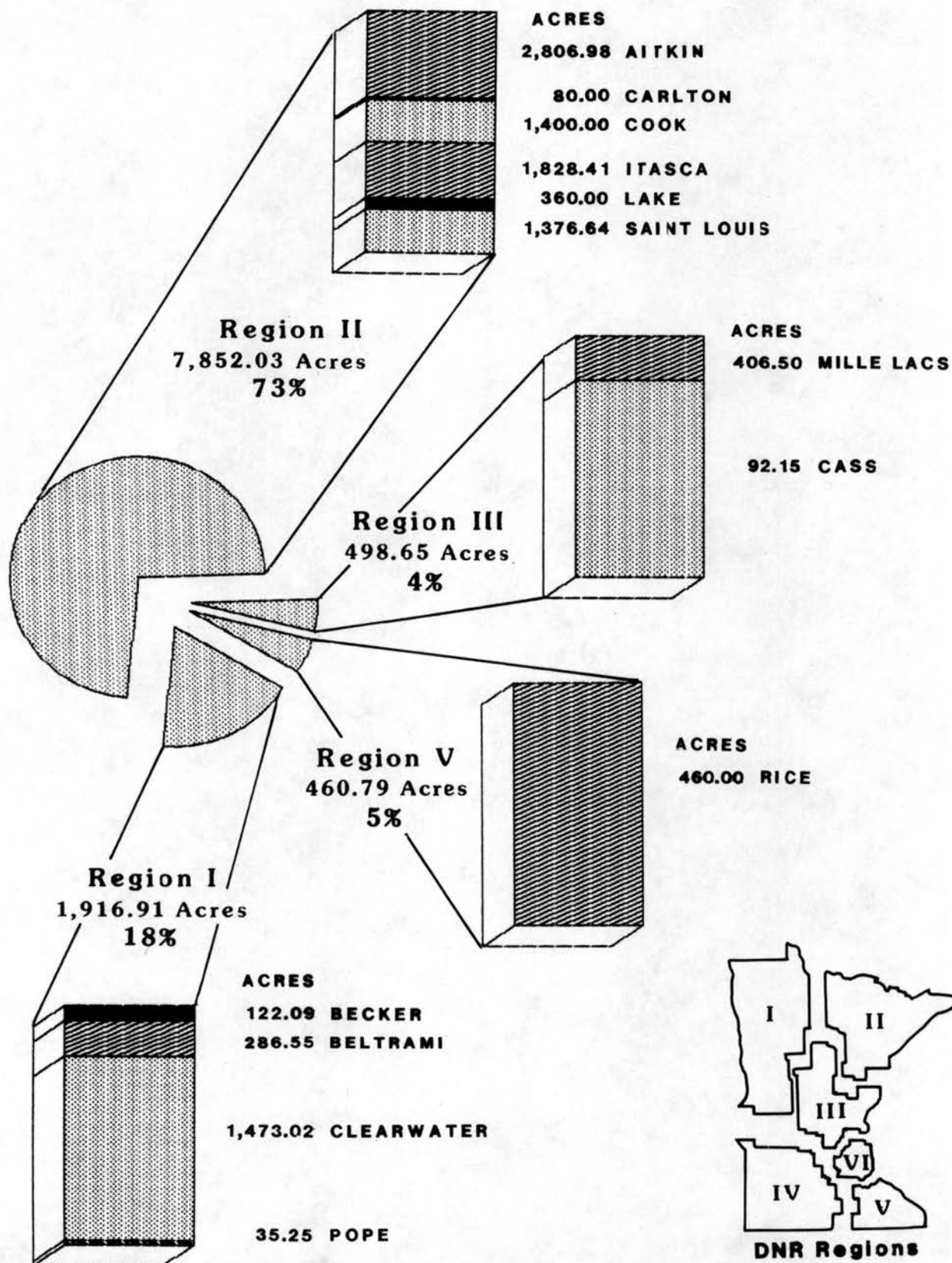
**Facility Breakdown

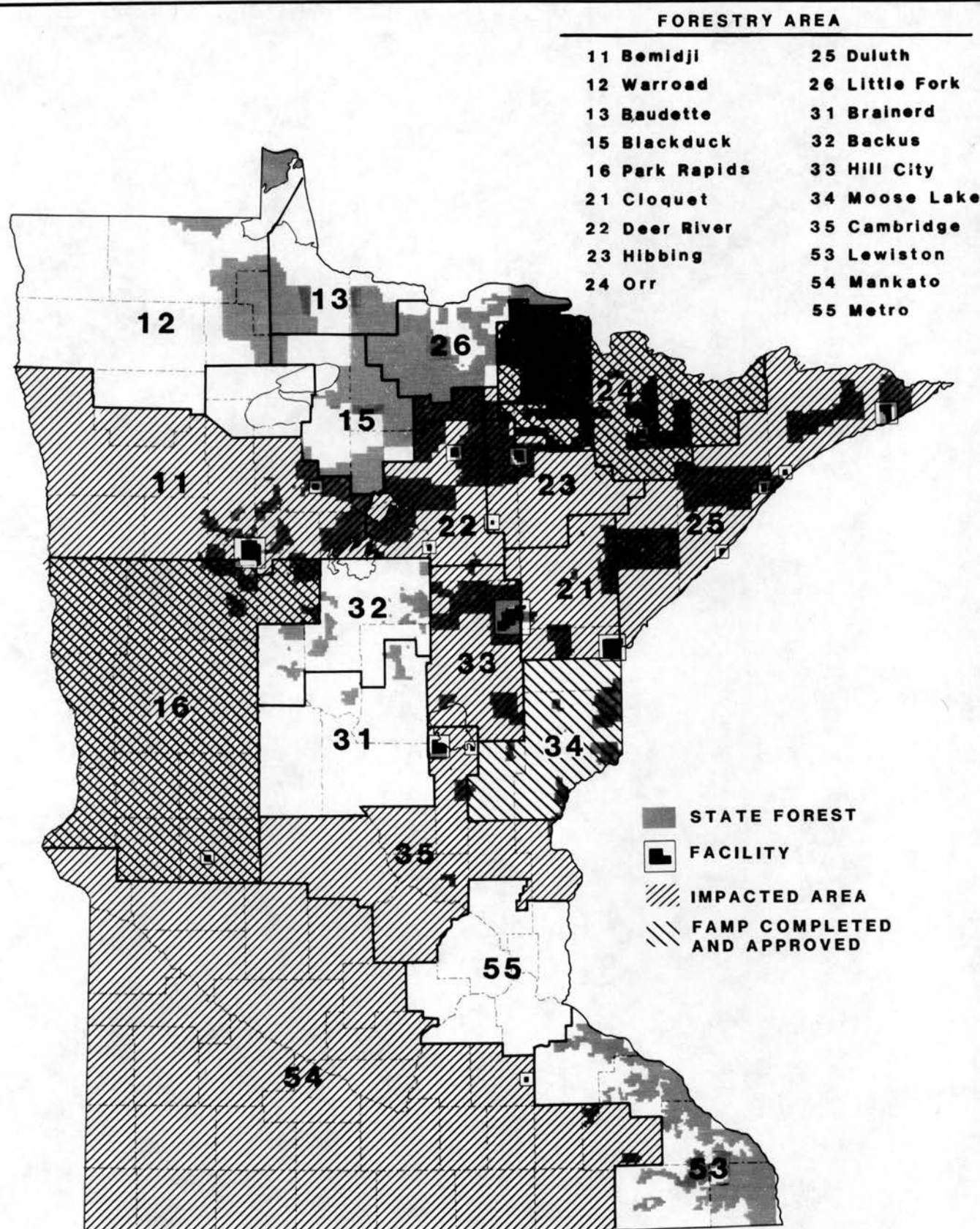
**Acres School Trust

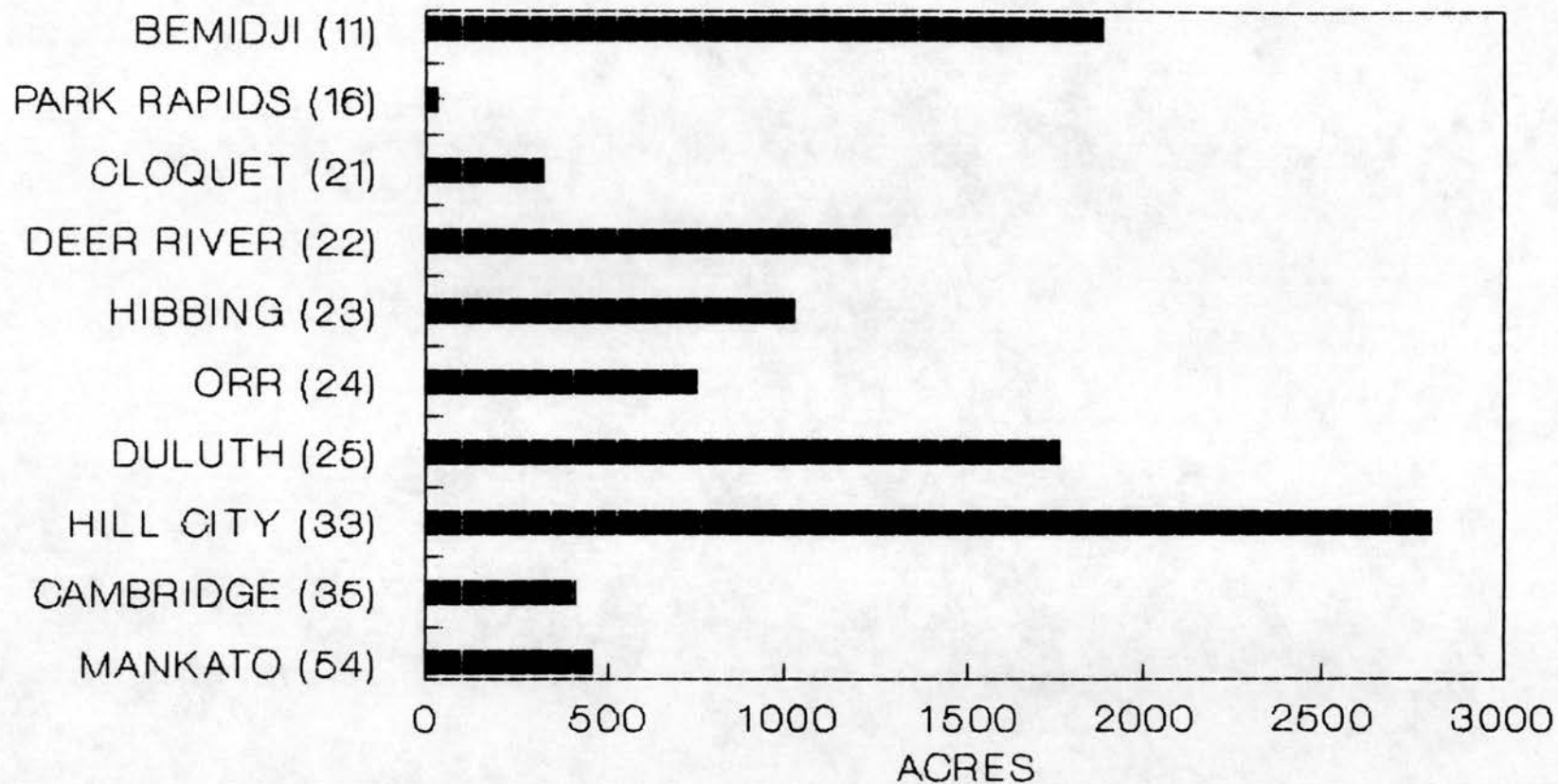


**State Forestry Areas

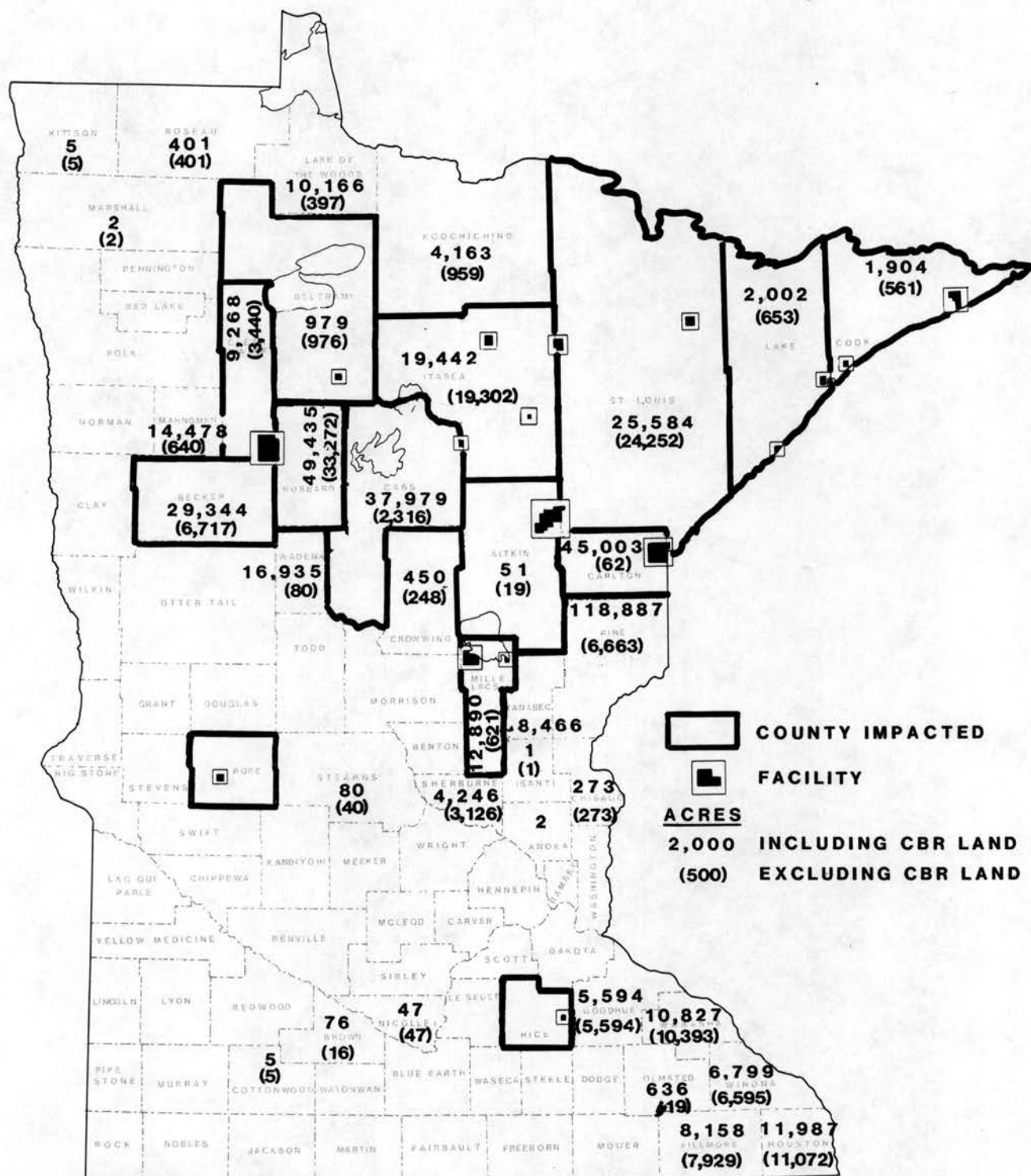

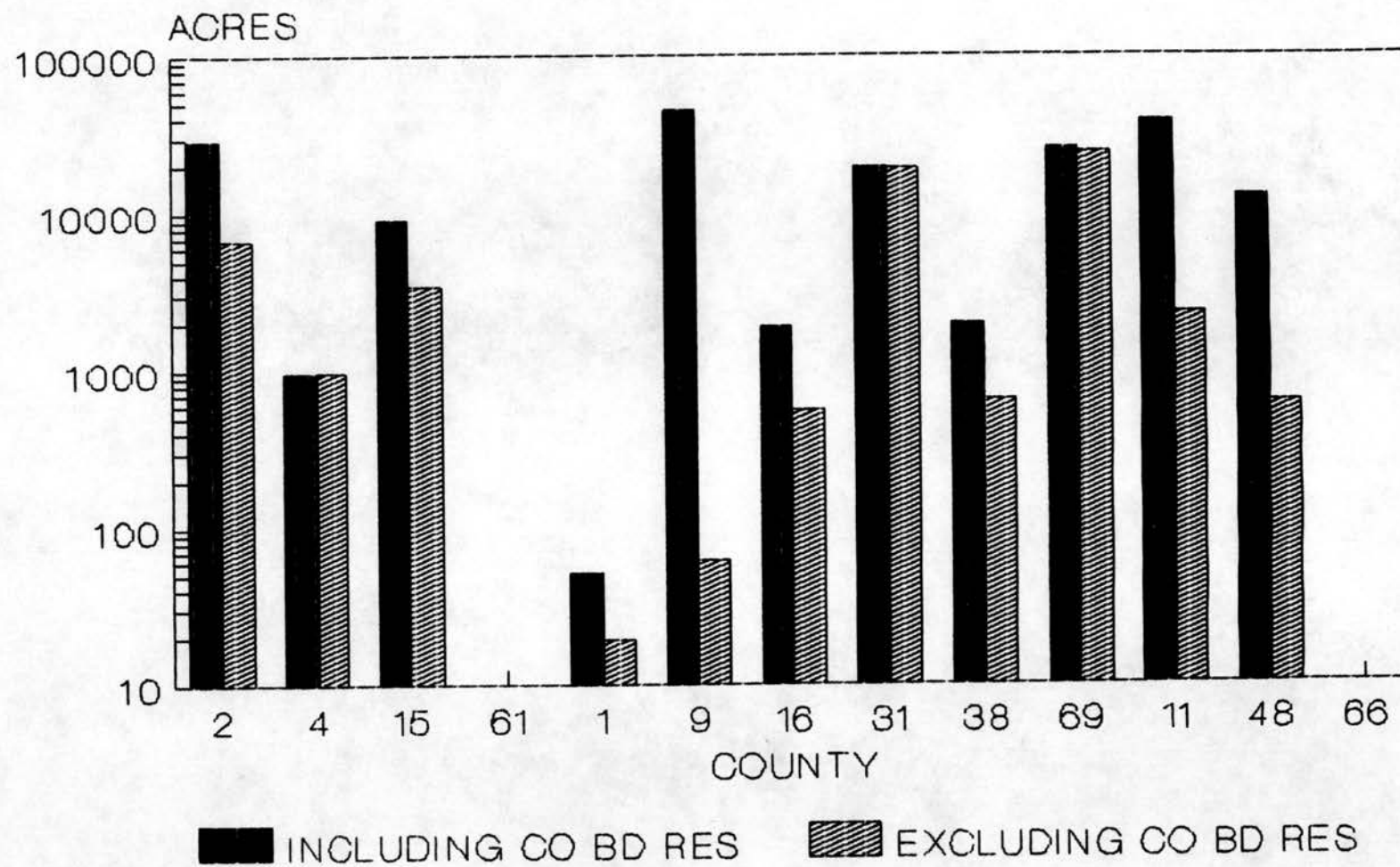

Report to the Legislature

In preparing the inventory required by Laws of 1975, Chapter 116, I noticed that the school land adjacent to George Crosby Manitou State Park has not been listed on your inventory. Although there is no trust land technically included inside the statutory boundary of the park, it appears that some of the park's trails and primitive campsites are located on these lands. Some of these trust parcels were classified as first priority lands to be acquired in a November 1978 letter to the chair of LCMR as they were "impacted lands" in the State Park System (enclosed).

I think that the 240 acres identified as critical in the plan for this park should be included in the inventory because they are either impacted by trails and campsites or are surrounded by trails which, practically speaking, include them in the park.

Based on correction work done by staff, the Park's inventory list has been revised and a copy is enclosed for your review.

Since we will be recommending exchange as a solution to the problem of trust lands in parks, the addition of these parcels in Manitou will be compatible with the exchange recommendation in the Park Plan.
