Arrested St Paul Nov 13-1909 for having in his possession \$2.71 in postage stamps stolen from station 19 Kansas City Mo. Indicted Nov 22-1909 at Stillwater Minn for Grand Larceny having stuck up Watch man at Wild Wood Minn and blew open and robbed safe. turned over to state authorities and arrested by them April 23-1910 and convicted on the Wild Wood job. Sentenced May 24th 1910 to serve 8 years Minn State Prison. Released from the Stillwater prison Jan 10-1916 and arrested by the federal authorities held for hearing and on March 27-1916 held for trial at Kansas City Mo sentenced at Kansas City Mo April 20-1916-5 months Platte County Jail for robbing K. C. Post office March 20-1909.
