



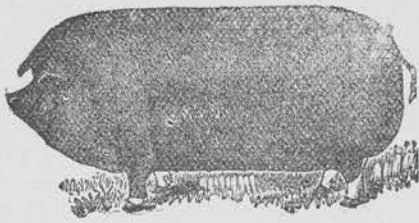

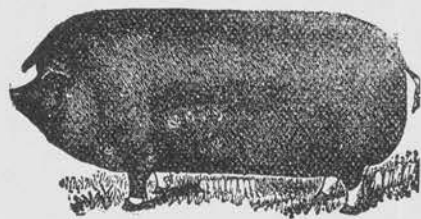

Guidons Select Seedlings One of ^{my} ~~the~~
trees fruited last season
It is the best seedling fruit that
my trees have yet produced and when
I say the best I do not say it with
the enthusiasm of a beginner who has
(over)

printed his first seedling and
imagines he has got the \$1000 apple
I have printed nearly 200 seedlings
of course I cannot say much about
it at present as only one specimen
matured. But it has quality size
and appearance, entirely overspread with
red or carmine, very shallow at the calyx
and also at the stem slightly oblong

Tree a strong upright grower

days and get some seed of Malinda
of course I must be in swim
