"The Horticulturist" which has been sent to R.M. Dartt at Owatonna should be discontinued. My brother died August 5<sup>th</sup> last at the Rochester Hospital. His mind which, became affected five years ago never improved and finally tuberculosis set in and carried him away. When he was first taken sick we hoped that at his age (24) he would outgrow the difficulty - but matter grew worse rather than better.

I have presented his horticultural reports, together with those of my late father to the Owatonna Public Library and I think we now have in the library nearly a complete set. I will take the matter up with the librarian & we may want to ask your assistance in securing missing volumes.

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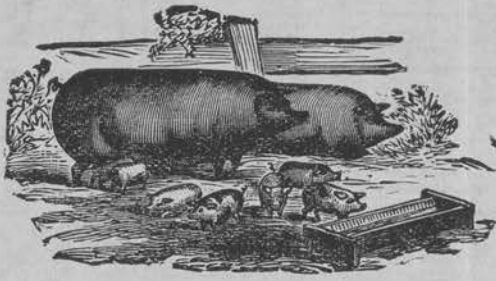
