I got 4 apple seedlings, the 4th is no doubt the Perkins seedling furnisht by Mr. Wyman Elliot, as stated in the Horticulturist of May 05. Have you any record of what was sent out under that head, to me? If so, would like to get the names of the seedlings; the plums are doing especially well, now full of blossoms; all four apples are growing, only one unusually thrifty, two of the others blighted back badly last year, as did the 4th, which is also scrawny and stunted. It seems to me it was an odd name, like Tetofsky or Charlamoff; I dont think the name of the plums were gver given me. Find stamp enclosed.
