WHEREAS, Counties in Minnesota have a substantial responsibility in the field of highway construction and maintainance, including matters relating to highway and traffic safety, which responsibility is shared by the counties with the communities within the respective counties, and

WHEREAS, Although the highway and traffic safety problem has had the attention of many groups, both governmental and non-governmental, the attention has been fragmented because each unit has been limited to its particular jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, It is the belief of the county boards of the eight counties of the Minneapolis-St. Paul metropolitan area that this problem will require, and will respond to, control and treatment measures developed and maintained on a regional basis:

Your committee recommends that the Board of County Commissioners of Hennepin County pledge its cooperation with other counties of the area, in attacking this major problem and to this end designates the Metropolitan Inter-County Council its agent to develop plans for a regional highway and traffic safety program involving both counties and municipalities of the area.

The Metropolitan Inter-County Council, in developing the coordinated plan, is requested to investigate the availability of funds from all sources which may be used to share the cost of this project so that the cooperating counties will be properly advised as to their responsibilities, financial and otherwise, when called on to implement an active program of highway accident control and prevention.
