The Board of County Commissioners for the County of Hennepin, Minnesota, met in the Hennepin County Government Center, in the City of Minneapolis, at 10:00 a.m., pursuant to law.

The meeting was called to order by Wayne A. Johnson, County Auditor.

Mr. Johnson called for nominations for Chairman of the County Board of Hennepin County for the year 1977.

Commissioner Sivanich nominated Commissioner Derus. There being no other nominations, nominations were declared closed.

Chairman Derus called for nominations to represent Hennepin

County on the Agriculture Extension Division. Commissioner Ticen

approved by unanimous roll-call vote.

Chairman Derus called for nominations to represent
Hennepin County on the Minneapolis Planning Commission.

Commissioner Sivanich nominated Commissioner Spartz. The
nomination was seconded by Commissioner Ticen and approved
unanimously by roll-call vote.

Chairman Derus called for nominations for Hennepin
County's representative on the Board of Trustees of the
Hennepin County Law Library for 1977. Commissioner Derus
