The Board of County Commissioners of Hennepin County, Minnesota, met in the Hennepin County Government Center in the City of Minneapolis, at 10:00 a.m., pursuant to law.

Commissioner Spartz was absent. All other Commissioners were present.

The meeting was called to order by John E. Derus, Chairman.

The minutes of the June 28, 1977 meeting were approved, as published in Finance and Commerce, Saturday, July 2, 1977.

The Board was advised of certain communications and the Chairman referred same for appropriate disposition.

There was a notice from the Clerk to the Board that a vacancy will exist on the Capital Budgeting Task Force as of August 7th, 1977 due to the term of Maryclaire Richardson ending on that date. Commissioner Sivanich moved that the vacancy be announced and those interested in being appointed submit their names prior to the Board meeting of the first Tuesday in August (August 2nd). The motion was seconded by Commissioner Robb and approved unanimously. (Spartz absent)

Chairman Derus suggested they be invited to appear before the Board after the County Administrator has made a report as directed in Resolution No. 77-6-780, and this was agreed to by the Commissioners.

Commissioner Ticen, seconded by Commissioner Derus

WHEREAS, the County Board, deeply concerned because of rising costs of both mandated and voluntary government services, intends to implement a budget review process which incorporates the most modern analytical techniques, including the Zero Base Budget approach, to budget matters.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the County hereby implements a budget policy which will be called the annual Alternate Resource Allocation System and that County operating departments be directed to prepare and submit to the Board their 1978 budget requests in the manner outlined in the Board policy statement entitled, "1978 Alternate Resource Allocation System", a copy of which is on file in the office of the County Board of Commissioners.

Commissioner Robb moved that the policy statement referred to in this resolution be amended in the third paragraph, ninth line, to include the word "total" before the words "budget request". The motion was approved unanimously (Spartz absent).

Commissioner Sivanich moved that a written evaluation of the ongoing programs within the various departments, and any suggested changes, be provided for the budget hearings. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Ticen and approved unanimously (Spartz absent).

When the patient-victim does not have medical insurance coverage for such diagnostic tests and/or treatment performed on the patient-victim at the time of the evidentiary medical examination as an outpatient, then Hennepin County is prepared to pay the examining facility or physician a maximum of \$100 for such diagnosis and treatment in addition to the aforementioned maximum \$135 payment for the medical evidentiary examination on the following conditions:
