To the People of the State of Minnesota, and particularly
of the Forty-third Senatorial District of said State;
to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota;
to the County Auditor of the County of Washington of
said State; to all Election Officials of said Forty-
third Senatorial District and of the several Election
Districts therein; and to all Others Whom it may Con-
cern - GREETING:

WHEREAS a vacancy now exists in the office of state
senator from the forty-third senatorial district of the
State of Minnesota, caused by the death of the late state
senator, the Honorable George H. Sullivan; and

WHEREAS, the state legislature is now in session and
the person elected to said office will have occasion to ex-
ercise the functions thereof immediately after his election;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Floyd B. Olson, as Governor of
the State of Minnesota, acting under the authority and di-
rection of Section 17 of Article 4 of the Constitution of
this state and the statutes in such case provided, do hereby
direct that a special election to fill said vacancy be held
in said district on Wednesday, the thirteenth day of March, 1935,
that a special primary election for the nomination of candi-
dates for said vacancy be held in said district on Wednesday,

the sixth day of March, 1935, that the affidavits of candidates for nomination at said primary be filed not later than the seventh day before said primary, to-wit, not later than Wednesday, the twenty-seventh day of February, 1935, that notices of said election and the special primary therefor, the nomination and election of candidates, and the conduct of said elections be had, and all things pertaining thereto be done, as provided by Laws 1929, Chapter 297, and amendments thereof, and other applicable provisions of law.
