

RESOLUTION

ELECTION BY THE RICE CREEK WATERSHED DISTRICT  
TO ADMINISTER THE PERMANENT PROGRAM  
UNDER THE WETLAND CONSERVATION ACT OF 1991


WHEREAS, the Rice Creek Watershed District is acting as the Local Government Unit administering the Interim Program within the Rice Creek Watershed District under the Wetland Conservation Act of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Rice Creek Watershed District desires to continue acting as the Local Government Unit in the Rice Creek Watershed District and administer within its boundaries the Permanent Program under the Wetland Conservation Act of 1991;


WHEREAS, under the Wetland Conservation Act of 1991 a Local Government Unit in the seven county metropolitan area, including Anoka, Hennepin, Ramsey and Washington Counties, is defined as: a city council, town board or water management organization under Minnesota Statutes section 103B.211; the Rice Creek Watershed District is such a watershed management organization and Local Government Unit under the Act;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rice Creek Watershed District elects to act as the Local Government Unit and administer within the boundaries of the Rice Creek Watershed District the Permanent Program under the Wetland Conservation Act of 1991, effective January 1, 1994.
