hereby appointed guardian of the person and estate of said minor; that before entering upon his
duties as such guardian, he take the oath required by law, and give bond to the Judge of this Court
in the sum of Five hundred DOLLARS, with sufficient sureties, to be
approved by said Judge, conditioned according to law, and that upon the filing and approval of such bond
Letters of Guardianship be to him issued.
