Contains the details of each county as organized, together with subsequent additions & subtractions from each county & the modification of boundary lines.

An act that defines a county, shows in detail the boundary, at that date, of such county, by twps ranges, sections, river boundaries etc.

Usually when a county is declared organized, the date of approval is given, the county seat is specified, always subject to the voters' approval.

When a county is declared organized but attached to another for judicial or elective purposes it means that county has no county officers; sheriff, county judge, attorney, clerk, etc. These are sometimes appointed temporarily by the governor until the next election is held.
