Called by the Sioux, as translated, Tokua Brothers Lake. This aboriginal name is spelled Ta Kara on Nicollet's map, 1843, Ta being the Sioux word for moose, while Kara doubtless refers to the Kahra band (over) of Sioux. Kahra means wild rice. This band frequently visited Lake Traverse

Tokua (or Toqua) was the white men's endeavor to spell the Sioux name for these lakes.

Samuel J. Brown, of the village of Brown's Valley, has stated that this name "was taken from a picture carved on a tree, meaning probably some animal so pictured." This accords well with the meaning of the name given by Nicollet, as the moose of the Kara or Kahra band of Sioux, perhaps a family totem or their mystic patron of the clan.

This may refer to East and West Toqua lakes in Graceville township. There is no lake of this name in Toqua twp.
