• The White Earth reservation was established by a treaty at Washington, Mar. 19, 1867. In the summer of the next year many Ojibways of the Mississippi and Gull Lake bands, led respectively by their chiefs, WA-GON-A-QUOT (White Cloud) and NA-GUN-ASH-KONG, removed there. June 14, 1868 was the day of arrival of the pioneers in the removal and its anniversary is celebrated at White Earth each year. 17 townships in Becker Co., the entire 16 townships in Mahanomen Co., and the next four of Range 38 in Clearwater Co., are included in the reservation area, being as fertile farming land as is found in any part of Minnesota.


