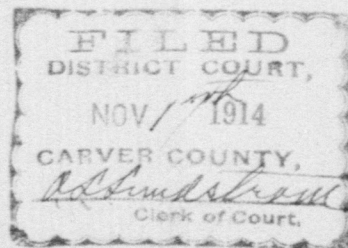

For a First Cause of Action:

1. That on, to-wit, February 18, 1914, plaintiff and defendant entered into an agreement by the terms of which plaintiff bought from defendant, and defendant sold to plaintiff, the tools, machinery, paraphernalia and the good will of the ice business owned by defendant and conducted by him in the Town of Young America in said county for the agreed price of \$700.00, and plaintiff on the making of said agreement paid to defendant on account of such agreed purchase price the sum of \$300.00.

2. That in the month of April, 1914, while defendant was still in possession of the property so purchased by plaintiff, plaintiff and defendant mutually agreed and consented to rescind and cancel said agreement, and said agreement was thereupon canceled and rescinded.

3. That plaintiff on, to-wit, June 8, 1914, demanded of defendant the return of said sum of \$300.00 so paid as aforesaid, and defendant then wrongfully and unlawfully refused, and ever since has so refused, to return to plaintiff said sum or any part thereof.

For a Second Cause of Action:

4. That on, to-wit, February 18, 1914, plaintiff, at defend-



ant's special instance and request, sold and delivered to defendant 147 bushels and 10 pounds of corn at the agreed price of 50 cents a bushel and 152½ bushels of oats at the agreed price of 36 cents a bushel.

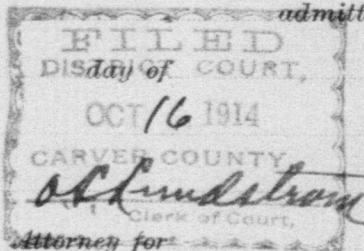

The defendant in the above entitled action for his answer to the complaint of the plaintiff therein alleges:

That said defendant denies said complaint and each and every allegation, statement and thing in said complaint contained and each and every part and portion thereof except as is hereinafter expressly admitted, qualified or otherwise explained.

Defendant alleges that on the 18th day of February, 1914, said plaintiff and said defendant entered into an agreement by the terms of which said plaintiff bought from said defendant and said defendant sold to said plaintiff the tools, machinery, paraphernalia and the good will of the ice business owned by defendant and conducted by him in the Town of Young America in said County for the agreed price of \$700.00, and it was further agreed by and between said plaintiff and said defendant that the sum of \$300.00 should be and the same was paid in cash on said 18th day of February 1914, and that the balance of said purchase price should be paid as follows, to-wit, ~~xxx~~ 300 bushels of corn at the agreed purchase price of 50 cents per bushel and \$250.00 in cash said corn to be delivered on or before the first day of March 1914 and said \$250.00 to be paid on or before said first day of March 1914, and it was further agreed by and between said plaintiff and said defendant that if said plaintiff failed and neglected to pay said balance of said purchase price or any part or portion thereof on or before said first day of March 1914, or any part or portion thereof, that said sum of \$300.00 so paid on said contract as part performance thereof and any and all partial



payments on the balance of said purchase price to be paid on said contract was to be and should be defaulted.

That said plaintiff wholly failed and neglected to pay to said defendant the balance to be paid as the remaining part of the purchase price of said property as aforesaid, to-wit, the tools, machinery, paraphernalia and the good will of said defendant's ice business, or any part or portion thereof except the sum of \$76.30 which said plaintiff paid to defendant by delivering to him 147 bushels and 10 pounds of corn referred to in paragraph 4 of plaintiff's cause of action herein and being the identical corn referred to in said paragraph four of said cause of action.

That because said plaintiff wholly failed and neglected to do and perform ~~of~~ all of the terms and conditions of his said agreement on his part to be done and performed said defendant was compelled to and did sell the tools, machinery, paraphernalia and the good will of said ice business so conducted by him to his great loss and damage.

Defendant admits that he purchased of plaintiff 152½ bushels of oats at the agreed price of 36 cents a bushel and that he has not paid plaintiff therefor.

#### Counter-claims

As and for a counter claim defendant alleges that by reason of the breach of said plaintiff's contract and agreement in not performing the conditions ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ and terms of his agreement with reference to the purchase of the tools, machinery, paraphernalia and the good will of said defendant's ice business herein, said defendant was compelled to sell the same at a great loss and to his damage in the sum of \$200.00 This defendant alleges for his first counter claim.

For his second counter claim defendant alleges that in the month of April, 1914, defendant sold plaintiff one certain horse for the agreed price of \$135.00 which said horse was returned to said defendant by plaintiff in a bad and injured condition, ~~and~~ after said plaintiff ~~defendant~~ retained said horse in his possession for 12 days, and

that said plaintiff paid said defendant ~~nothing~~ for said horse or for the use thereof, and that the value of the use of said horse for said for said 12 days was \$10.00, and that the diminution of the value of said horse for the injuries that said horse sustained while in the possession of said plaintiff was \$15.00.

Wherefore defendant demands judgment:

That plaintiff take nothing herein.

That defendant have judgment against plaintiff for the sum of \$225.00, together with his costs and disbursements herein.
