

upon the performance of said contract and entered into the employ of Defendant and continued in its employ under the aforesaid contract from May 1st, 1907, until on or about May 20th, 1907, a period of two-thirds (2/3) of a month, the salary of said period being two-thirds (2/3) of the said salary for one month.

That on or about said date, the Defendant wrongfully

That the conduct of the Defendant in said discharging Plaintiff this Befordant and refusing to permit him to carry out the terms of hiring was without cause.

by Defendant, the sum of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) and that by reason of the wrongful acts of the Defendant in discharging him as aforesaid, and in refusing to allow him to perform the terms and conditions of the aforesaid contract, of hiring, he has been damaged in the sum of seven hundred twenty-five dollars (\$725.00) and that by reason of all the aforesaid facts, this Plaintiff has been damaged in the sum of eight hundred dollars (\$800.00).

WHETEWORE, Plaintiff demands judgment against the Defendant for the sum of eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) with interest from date **************** together with the costs and disbursements of this action.
