

My dear Judge:-

I called at the office of the Clerk of the District Court at Chaska yesterday, pursuant to notice of Taxation of costs served upon you prevolusly. The Clerk showed me your objections thereto.

You remember in the 1st appeal which was tried at Norwood, the Judge dismissed the appeal and tried case on Merits at same time. In this you would be entitled to \$10.00 Dollars costs on Merits, but upon an order to show cause in the same matter, why the Judge should not amend his findings, the Judge simply dismissed the appeal granting the amendment I prayed for. This reduced your costs on dismissal to \$5.00 Dollars, but costs were awarded to me on my order to show cause amounting to \$5.00 Dollars or in the Language of Centlemen who shake dice - "Horse a Piece" However, you have seen fit to cause Judgment to be entered on your order of Dismissal with Costs and I had to retaliate by having Judgment entered on my order to show cause with costs.

The Clerk, however, has included in your Judgment \$3.00, Clerks
Fee's which I have already paid him and which he admits to be error. Your
Judgment should be \$5.00 costs and \$8.41 Clerks Fee's or \$7.41, while my
Judgment is \$5.00 costs and \$1.95 clerks Fee's or \$6.95.

In the Second appeal remanding cause to Probate Court for further consideration the Clerk did not include either his own Fees or any disbursements but simply the Statutory costs \$10.00. There has been so many moves in the case that it - has bothered the Clerk to keep track of them. I told Mr. Muchlberg that you and Mr. Fahey would be at Chaska on the 17th or 25th of March and that we would set him right on these costs matters.

It appeared from the return of probate court that Anna Kersten was duly and regularly appointed administratrix of said estate upon her petition to said court, showing among other things that she was he surviving spouse of John Kersten, decedent, and, as such, was entitled to be appointed as such administratrix by the probate court of said county under Sec. 3696, R. L. 1905, there being no objection to her appointment at the time said petition was heard, and no appearance n any manner on the part of the appellant until an appeal was taken o this Court more than 30 days after the order of the probate court appointing said administratrix.

This is not an appeal from the order of the probate court refusing to remove said administratrix, but it is contended by the appellant that this Court has the power and authority to remove the administratrix on the proceedings now before the Court. In that contention I cannot concur. The Court is of the opinion that, if any cause ex-

ists for the removal of the administratrix from the office to which she has been appointed by the probate court of said county, the application for such removal must be first addressed to the probate court, and from the order refusing to remove the administratrix the appellant could appeal, and upon such appeal this Court would then have authority to order such removal, provided the evidence so warranted.

The evidence adduced at the hearing in this case does not show any cause whatever why the administratrix should be removed from her office, even if the Court had the authority under the proceedings now before it, to order such removal.

It is therefore ORDERED. That the said order and decision of the probate court of Carver county, made on the 8th day of November, A. D. 1907, appointing Anna Kersten administratrix of the estate of said decedent in the above entitled cause be, and the same hereby is, in all things affirmed, with costs.

Let judgement be entered accordingly.
