In the matter of the delinquency
of Adelard Cunin.

Whereas, on the 11th day of July, 1907, Adelard Cunin was duly brought before this court upon the petition of W.S. Brill, filed herein July 10, 1907, alleging that said Adelard Cunin was a delinquent child, and it having been made to appear to the satisfaction of the Court on said first named date that said delinquent is a minor under the age of seventeen years and over the age of eight years, to-wit, fifteen years of age, and was then and there found to be a delinquent child and the proper subject of the state's guardianship and care, and said court did then and there adjudge and determine that said infant be committed to and be placed in the Minnesota State Training School for boys and girls, under the guardianship of the Board of Control of state institutions according to the statute in such case made and provided,

And whereas, on the 12th day of July, 1906, this court filed its order of commitment herein committing said delinquent child as aforesaid, and thereafter on the 16th day of July, 1907, said case was duly reopened and execution of said order of commitment was duly stayed until September 28, 1907.

And whereas on the 2nd day of August, 1907, the execution of said order of commitment was stayed until the 3rd day of June, 1908, and whereas on the 27th day of August, 1907, said Adelard Cunin was arrested and brought before this court on a charge of delinquency, and it appearing to this Court at this time, after hearing testimony, that said child is a proper subject of the state's guardianship and care, and that the orders heretofore made herein on July 16, 1907, and August 2, 1907, staying the execution of the order committing said Adelard Cunin

to the State Training School at Red Wing, should each be vacated and set aside. Now, therefore, upon the recommendation of the Probation Officer of Ramsey county, Minnesota, and upon the testimony herein,

ORDERED, that the orders of this Court made herein July 12, 1907, and August 2, 1907, respectively, staying execution of the order committing said Adelard Cunin to the Minnesota State Training School for boys and girls, under the guardianship of the Board of Control of state institutions be and they are each in all things vacated and set aside.

ORDERED FURTHER, that the order of commitment made and entered herein July 12, 1907, adjudging and determining that said infant be committed to and be placed in the Minnesota State Training School at Red Wing, for boys and girls, under the guardianship of the Board of Control of state institutions, according to the statute in such case made and provided, be and is in all things in force, and that the sheriff of Ramsey county or the Probation Officer in and for said county forthwith take custody of and deliver said Adelard Cunin into the care and custody of the Board of Control of state institutions at the Minnesota State Training School for boys and girls at Red Wing, in Goodhue county, Minnesota, and that said Board receive and take said Adelard Cunin into their custody and keep him according to law or until he shall have been discharged by due course of law or by the rules of said Board.

Brill wherein it was alleged that the said Adelard Cunin was a delinquent child, and it having been made to appear to the satisfaction of the Court that the said Adelard Cunin was and is a minor under the age of seventeen years and over the age of eight years, to-wit, fifteen years of age, and that the said Adelard Cunin was found to be a delinquent child and the proper subject of the State's guardianship and care, said court did adjudge and determine that said infant be committed to and be placed in the Minnesota State Training School for boys and girls under the guardianship of the Board of Control of State Institutions, according to the statute in such case made and provided.

Now, Therefore, in the name of the State of Minnesota, you are hereby commanded forthwith to convey the said Adelard Cunin, and deliver him into the custody of the Board of Control of State Institutions at the Minnesota State Training School for Boys and Girls in Goodhue County, Minnesota, and you, the said Board of Control, are hereby commanded and directed to receive the said Adelard Cunin into your custody and to safely keep him he until shall have been discharged by due course of law or by the rules of said Board.

HON. OLIN B. LEWIS, J. (Thursday a.m. July 11, 1907.)

ADELARD CUNIN, Sworn, testified:

I am fifteen years old. Will be sixteen the 21st of this coming August. My father is Julius Cunin. My mother's name is Dina Cunin. My home is at 105 South Wabasha. My father's business is raising mush-rooms, at the foot of the high steps. Have lived with my father and mother all my life. I am working; stopped school last year. I was in the A-5th. I attended night school. I have had trouble before and was brought in here and was committed to the Training School at Red Wing, and the sentence suspended. That was for fighting. Had no trouble until the other night. We were chasing some horses down below State street, a lot of fellows, down by the boats where they swim. The horses belonged to a Jew and we was going to bring them up to the Jew on State street. The Jew didnt send us after the horses. We were going to catch them and ride them up to the Jew's and incidentally get a ride part way home. After we chased them awhile a fellow came up back of me and knocked me down. I dont know who the fellow was. He didnt say nothing to me. He hit me with his fist and then he knocked me down and kicked me in the head. He told me to get out of there. Then I walked a little ways and I met another boy, and I stood there and watched him, and then he made a rush at me and I started to run and he tripped me and throwed me down.

Q. And you cut him pretty bad, didnt you, you stuck the knife right into him? A. Yes.

The Officer: He had eight stitches taken in it.

Mr.Graves states that the boy was sentenced to the State Training School by Judge Orr last April and the sentence suspended and the boy placed on probation; that he has reported fairly regularly, but complaints have been made as to the boy being out late at nights; that the boy is inclined to be wayward and associate with bad company, and recommends that for the best interest of the boy he be sent to the school for awhile.

The Court: Upon the evidence presented and the recommendation of the Probation Officer, the order heretofore entered herein by Judge Orr suspending the order committing him to the State School is vacated and set aside, and the order which Judge Orr has heretofore made with reference to this boy, committing him to the State Training School, is in all things in force.

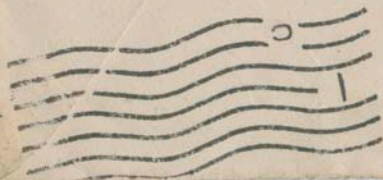

The State Board of Control have adopted the following rules concerning inmates of this Institution, and their parents and friends will please govern themselves accordingly, as the same will be strictly enforced.

Visits to inmates will be allowed on the first and third Saturdays of each month only between the hours of 10 a. m. and 12 m.

Visitors coming on trains whose arriving time is such as to make visit inconvenient during hours mentioned above, may arrange for their visit by correspondence with the Superintendent.

No inmate will be allowed more than one visit in each month and all visits must be made in the presence of an officer of the Institution.

No visits will be allowed on Sundays or holidays.

Visitors will be entertained at dinner and will be conveyed to the depot.

A visiting card will be furnished to the parents or guardian of each inmate which card must be produced by the visitor and the date of the visit endorsed thereon.

Inmates may receive a reasonable quantity of fruit, candy, etc., but other food will not be allowed.

Inmates will not be allowed the use of the telephone. In case of illness or any other important matter, telephone messages may be delivered to any inmate by the Superintendent or other officers.

Inmates will not be permitted to receive any article of clothing.

Former inmates will on no account be allowed to visit any inmate of the Institution, nor will letters from or to former inmates be allowed to pass.

Inmates who have not lost more than fifty credits during the preceding thirty days, will be permitted to write one letter on the Sunday nearest the 20th of each month. Writing material and stamp for this letter will be furnished by the State.

Inmates who have not been reported for an infraction of the rules during the preceding week may be permitted to write one letter on any other Sunday, writing material and stamp for such letter must be furnished by the inmate or his friends.

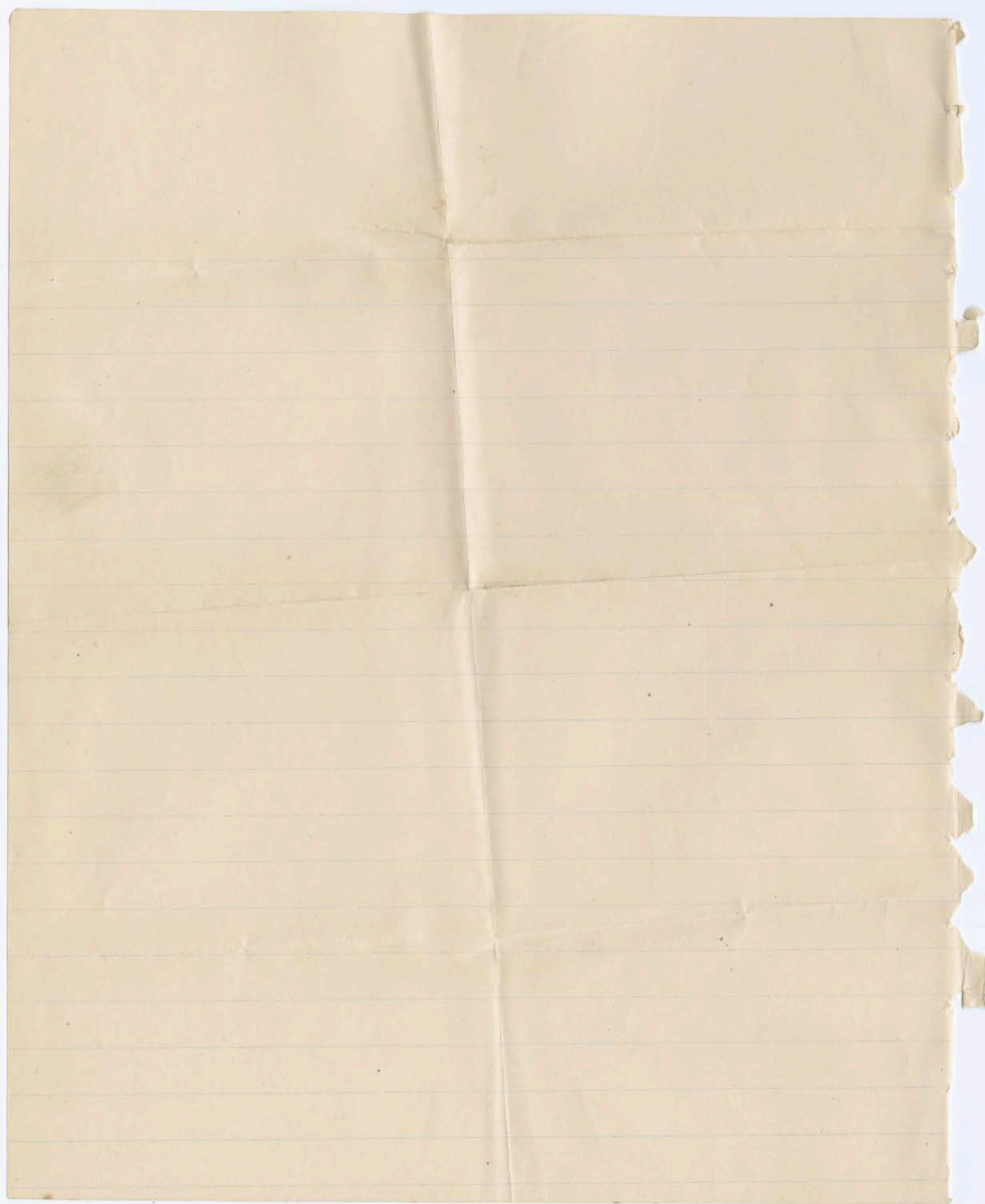

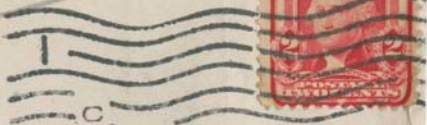
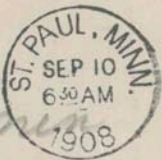
