

As Clyde Champion Barrow, No. 4316, arrested police department, Fort Worth, Texas, February 22, 1928; charge, investigation; dismissed.

As Clyde Barrow, No. 6048, arrested police department, Dallas, Texas, October 13, 1929; charge attempted burglary and safe burglary; indictment quashed.

As Clyde Barrow, alias Elvin Williams, No. 414, arrested police department,Waco, Texas, March 2, 1930; charge, burglary; sentence, 14 years Texas State Peniten-

tiary; escaped County Jail, Waco, Texas, March II, 1930.

As Clyde Barrow, No. 765, arrested police department Middletown, Ohio, March 18, 1930; charge, fugitive.

As Clyde Barrow, No. 63527, received Texas State Penitentiary, Huntsville, Texas, April 21, 1930, from McLennan County; charge, burglary, theft over and from the person; sentence 14 years (7-2's, cum.); paroled February 2, 1932.
