CARROLL IDENTIFIED

IN \$46,000 S. D. RAID

Two Others Also Linked by Witnesses With Robbery in Sioux Falls.

Positive identification of Tommy Carroll and two others as members of the gang of machine-gun bandits who robbed the Security National bank in Sioux Falls, S. D., of \$46,000 March 6 was announced by the sheriff's office at Sioux Falls Saturday, the Associated Press reported.

Carroll, who was arrested in St. Paul in September and released two days later, is said to be a former confederate of Verne Miller, slain gangster and once sheriff at Huron, S. D. Wanted with Carroll for the Sioux Falls robbery are Frank (Porky) Dillon, one-time Touhy gangster, and George (Baby Face) Nelson, escaped Illinois convict.

Pictures shown to witnesses of the raid led to identification of the trio. From a stack of photographs of suspects, twelve witnesses unhesitatingly picked out the picture of Nelson as the gunner who shot Hale Keith, motorcycle patrolman, through a bank window while the holdup was in progress. Keith is recovering from his wounds.

Dillon and Carroll were named as the outside guards who held nearly 1,000 townspeople at bay in the streets during the robbery, occasionally firing intimidating bursts from their machine-guns. Carroll, witnesses said, was the man who captured four police officers during the holdup.

Here is Carroll's record:

January 24, 1920—Arrested in Omaha, investigation, 60 days in jail.

October 24, 1921—Arrested in Council Bluffs, Iowa, auto theft, sentenced to five years in the Anamosa, Iowa, reformatory; served thirteen months, paroled.

November 21, 1924—Arrested in Kansas City for robbery.

August 11, 1925—Arrested in St. Louis as James Roy Brock as a robber suspect.

August 18, 1926—Arrested in St. Joseph, Mo., for auto theft.

September 19, 1926—Arrested in Tulsa, Okla., as Frank Slone for carrying concealed weapons.

April 1, 1927—Received at the Jefferson City, Mo., state prison for a five-year term for robbery.

May 21, 1930—Sentenced as Frank Sloan to 21 months in Leavenworth prison under the Dyer act (transporting stolen automobile over a state line).

May 17, 1933—Arrested in St. Paul for possession of burglar tools and turned over to United States authorities as a postoffice robber; released under \$15,000 bond.

September 4, 1933—Arrested by St.

Paul police when a gun and clips
bullets were found in his car after
an automobile accident at Rice street
and Wheelock parkway; released
September 6.

He also is wanted for the \$32,000
robbery of the First National bank
of Brainerd, Minn., October 23, 1933.
He kicked a Minneapolis policeman
in the face November 11, 1933,
escape arrest.

Sioux Falls authorities said that
Carroll and the two others are wanted
at various points in the Midwest for
bank robberies and other major
crimes. Both Nelson and Carroll
Chief of Police M. W. Parsons said
have been identified as having participated
in the robbery of the First
National bank at Mason City, March
13. Witnesses of the raid there, however,
said they could not be certain that
Dillon also was present.

Sheriff Melvin L. Sells also has
hopes of connecting Frank Denn
Carpenter, who resembles John Dillinger,
Indiana desperado, with the
Sioux Falls robbery. Carpenter, arrested
in Minneapolis, is held at
Rochester for bank robbery, and
Sheriff Sells expects to go there with
witnesses of the Sioux Falls robbery
to view him. He had planned to
leave Saturday but his departure was
delayed.

Private detectives and Melvin Pas
solt, superintendent of the Minnesota
Bureau of Criminal Apprehension,
have expressed doubt, however,
that Carpenter was involved in
the Sioux Falls holdup.
