ably believed by the arresting officer to be fugitives from justice, (c) of all persons in whose possession, when arrested, are found concealed firearms or other dangerous weapons, burglar tools or outfits, high-power explosives, or articles, machines or appliances usable for an unlawful purpose and reasonably believed by the arresting officer to be intended for such purposes, and within 24 hours thereafter to forward such finger print records and other identification data on such forms and in such manner as may be prescribed by the superintendent to the bureau of criminal apprehension.

Section 8, Chapter 197, Laws 1935 to be known as Section 9950-22 of Mason's Minn. Statutes. If any public official charged with the duty of furnishing to the bureau fingerprint records, reports or other information required by this act shall neglect or refuse to comply with such requirement, the bureau in writing shall notify the state, county or city officer charged with the issuance of a warrant for the payment of the salary of such official. Upon the receipt of such notice, such state, county or city official shall withhold the issuance of a warrant for the payment of the salary or other compensation accruing to such officer for the period of thirty days thereafter until notified by the bureau that such suspension has been released by the performance of the required duty.

This law should be strictly adhered to.

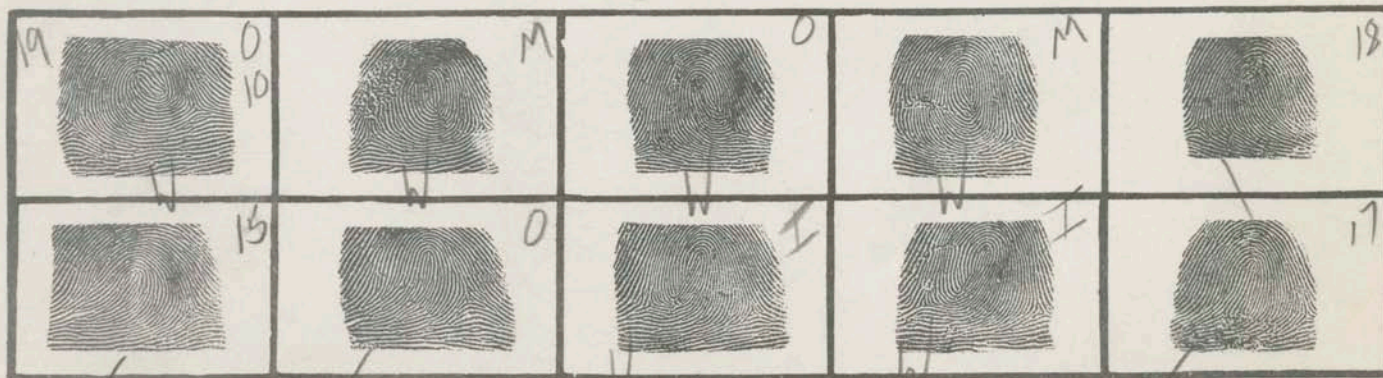

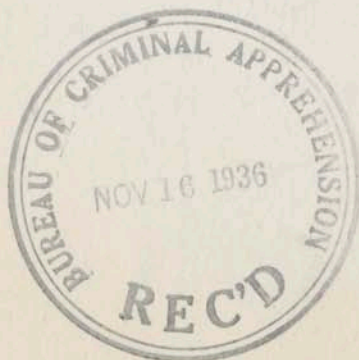

On June 15, 1937, Homer Cummings, Attorney General of the United States, under authority vested in him by law, offered the following rewards:

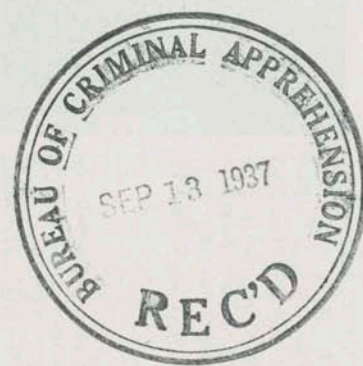

BRADY GANGSTER TO FACE MURDER TRIAL

Indianapolis, Ind., Oct. 13.—(UP)—State police said today James Dalhover, surviving member of the Brady gang, who is expected to be returned to Indiana immediately, would be prosecuted in connection with the slaying of State Policeman Paul Minneman, 31, last May.

Captain Walter Eckert, Osgood, indicated authorities would concentrate their efforts solely on the murder charge resulting from Minneman's death and for a time at least, disregard three other murders which Dalhover attributed to the gang in a reported confession to Bangor police.

Dalhover was a crack rifleman, state police said, and presumably the "trigger-man" for the Brady gang. He poured lead from a sawed-off shotgun into Minneman, they declared, and they want a verdict of death—the same fate of Al Brady, leader of the gang, and his lieutenant, Clarence Lee Shaffer, who were slain by G-men yesterday.
